On production of a Dartford Football Club season ticket, supporters will be able to purchase a 75p single journey on most Arriva services anywhere in the Kent Thameside Urban area to attend matches at Princes Park, Dartford.

Season ticket holders attending matches at Princes Park from other locations in the Kent Thameside Urban requiring a change of bus will be able to make each single journey for 75p (i.e. £3.00 return). Season ticket holders will be able to purchase the reduced rate up to 2 hours before the kick off time. There will not be a time restriction on travel after the match until the end of service on that day.

For Junior Season ticket holders at Dartford Football Club the cost of each single journey will be 40p. For its launch on Tuesday 29th January 2008 Dartford season ticket holders can obtain this special offer to travel Stonebridge Rd, Northfleet for the Kent Senior Cup match against Ebbsfleet United.

Football Special tickets are not available on the Fastrack A service or routes 428 and 492 operated by Arriva on behalf of Transport for London.
