Global 3000 Payroll V7.3 Installation (Overview)

1. Introduction

This document provides some background to the Global 3000 Payroll installation. It should be read **before** installing Global 3000 Payroll V7.3.

The pre-requisites for Global 3000 Payroll V7.3 are a 32-bit version of GSM; and GSM SP-16, or later. This Technical Note describes the precise requirements for Global 3000 Payroll V7.3 and provides an overview of the installation process. The companion Technical Note IN297 describes the installation Global 3000 Payroll in complete detail.

2. Overview of Product Delivery and Installation

Global 3000 Payroll is distributed within a Global Cabinet File (GCF) on the GPS CD. It requires a Global Product Licence File to activate and install the software. Please refer to Technical Note IN297 for full details of the installation procedure.

Global 3000 Payroll V7.3 is installed by the 3rd generation of the Global installation procedure. This section provides a description of the 3 generations of installation procedures.

The 1st software installation procedure, familiar to those who have installed a G-2000 product, including Payroll V6.8, involves running the \$INSOFT program to install, via an xxINS installation job, from a serialised, hand-generated diskette or hard-disk "postbox" volume (e.g. use PRINS to install from a PRA volume).

The 2nd software installation procedure, which is currently employed for Global 3000 V5.0, involves installing the software from a Global Cabinet File (GCF) distributed on the GPS CD (or downloaded from the Global website). This installation involves the activation of the GCF(s) via a Global Product Licence File using the \$LICENCE utility. The activated GCF is then used to install the product(s) using the (16-bit) \$INSTALL utility. This installation requires the presence of an Installation Log File, \$\$INSLOG, on the \$\$L unit.

The 3rd software installation procedure used for Global 3000 Payroll V7.3, which was first employed for Global 3000 Payroll V7.0, is very similar to the procedure employed for Global 3000 V5.0.

A 3rd generation installation procedure involves installing the software from a Global Cabinet File (GCF) distributed on the GPS CD (or downloaded from the Global website). This is a multi-stage procedure consisting of the following operations:

• use \$LICENCE to activate the GCF(s) via a Global Product Licence File;

- EXISTING USERS OF GLOBAL 3000 PAYROLL V7.2 CAN IGNORE THIS STEP:
 use \$INSLOG to create an Installation Log File, \$\$INSLOG, on the \$\$L unit. This stage
 is only required if a \$\$INSLOG file is not already present. Note that for GSM SP-15
 either \$INSLOG or \$CUS can be used to create the Installation Log File. However,
 you are advised to use 32-bit, GX \$INSLOG rather than 16-bit, text-mode \$CUS;
- install the product(s) from the activated GCF's using the (32-bit) \$SETUP utility.

The following table summarises the various generations of the product installation procedure:

3	Global 3000 Payroll V7.1	Yes	Yes	\$SETUP
3	Global 3000 Payroll V7.2	Yes	Yes	\$SETUP
3	Global 3000 Payroll V7.3	Yes	Yes	\$SETUP

3. Detailed Pre-Requisites

The most fundamental pre-requisite for the installation of Global 3000 Payroll V7.3 on a **GX thin-client** is a GSM version that is either:

GSM (Windows) Service Pack-16

GSM-PM (Windows) Service Pack-16

GSM (Unix) Service Pack-16

GSM-PM (Unix) Service Pack-16

GSM (Novell) Service Pack-16, with a 32-bit client

GSM-PM (Novell) Service Pack-16, with a 32-bit client

Note that Global 3000 Payroll V7.3 itself can be run on a non-GX screen. Thus, it is possible to install the product on a single GX screen, use \$GSP to apply Global Product Service Packs on a single GX screen, but continue to use the Payroll product itself on a non-GX screen(s).

Note also that GSM SP-16 is available on the Global Product Set CD that contains the PR73_060301.GCF Global Cabinet File.
