Ryman Premier

HAMPTON are back on top of the table after edging out previous leaders **Whitehawk** with a lone, late goal at the Beveree on Saturday.

It was one of many games to attract an excellent Non-League Day crowd, the attendance of 616 being more than double the turn-out for Hampton's midweek win over Lewes.

A tight game produced few chances, through Hampton's Joel Ledgister had a goal disallowed and another effort cleared off the line.

A goalless draw would have kept Hawks on top but their hopes were shattered six minutes from time when Charlie Moone grabbed his tenth goal of the season. It was his fifth in the league, where Hampton's 11 goals in eight games have produced 20 points thanks to their unyielding defence.

Kingstonian moved into second spot, bouncing back from their 5-2 thrashing at Wealdstone in midweek to end the division's last 100 per cent record with a 3-1 victory in front of 845 at **Lowestoft**.

A neatly-worked free-kick move allowed Andre McCollin to open the scoring after 11 minutes. Joe Francis equalised for the Trawlerboys in added time at the end of the first half but K's still departed for the dressing-rooms with a lead as Matt Pattison rifled home a stunning 35-yard drive. McCollin made sure in the 78th minute with his seventh league goal of the season, putting him two clear in the race for the division's Golden Boot.

Wealdstone, who topped the table for 24 hours after beating Kingstonian, are fourth after being held to a 2-2 draw by bottom club **Thurrock**, their first away point. Charlie Stimson gave the visitors a 37th-minute lead but a deflected shot by Kurtney Brooks made it 1-1 at half-time and Lawrence Yiga's 75th-minute own goal put Stones ahead. The majority of the 703 crowd were to be disappointed, however, as Matt Pooley grabbed a late leveller.

Margate suffered a second successive disappointment at home. Beaten by two late Concord goals in midweek, they let two points slip even later when Karl Beckford's shot in the fourth minute of added time went in off both posts to give **Lewes** a 1-1 draw. Sam Long's 35th-minute strike had seemed to be enough for the hosts.

Harrow collected their first away points of the season at the fifth attempt with a 1-0 victory at **Bury**. Nicolai Tararov scored after 11 minutes and John Sands came closest to an equaliser, heading against the bar.

Only two clubs in the division were seeking their first league wins anywhere, and both were successful. Two Greg Ngoyi goals got **Hendon** off the mark with a 2-1 home win over **Leiston**, now the only side in the division yet to collect a point on their travels. Emmanuel Osei pulled one back before half-time but that was it.

Carshalton also banked three points for the first time thanks to a 70th-minute goal by Jordan Clarke which was enough to see off visitors **Hastings**. Both sides had further chances but were unable to take them.

Cray, who had drawn their three previous away games, improved on that with a 3-1 victory at **Enfield Town**, spurred on by Jack Clark's fourth-minute free-kick opener. Alex Stavrinou made it 2-0 on the stroke of half-time but it needed a late Leigh Bremner penalty to clinch the points after Adam Wallace revived Enfield's hopes early in the second half.

A serious injury to defender Steve Sheehan had its effect on **East Thurrock**, who had dominated their game at **Met Police** and were 2-0 up after 21 minutes with goals from Sam Higgins and Hakeem Araba. They lost concentration after Sheehan suffered a suspected broken leg on the hour and the Met escaped with a 2-2 draw. Jonte Smith's 13th goal in eight games reduced the arrears in the 84th minute, Staforde Palmer levelled matters four minutes later and the hosts might have won it in the ten minutes of added time.

Bognor defender James Crane fired his fourth goal of the season to give his side a 16th-minute lead at **Canvey**. Bradley Woods-Garness replied for the islanders six minutes later and it was to finish 1-1.

Two clubs whose defensive records were among the league's poorest met at **Wingate** and the result, perhaps inevitably, was a 0-0 draw. Tony Stokes, whose late goals earned **Concord** that midweek win at Margate, again had the chance to snatch two extra points with time running out but shot over the bar.

UNBEATEN **Maldon** are the new leaders, though they had a scare or two before seeing off bottom club **Ware** by the odd goal in seven on Saturday.

They were two up in eight minutes through Lewis Dark and Billy Sendall, and when Bradley Fraser pulled one back on the half-hour the hosts responded with two more goals in the next five minutes, from Chris Bryan and Johnathan Glowacki.

A massacre threatened, but instead it was Ware who did the rest of the scoring. Spencer Knight reduced the arrears with a 65th-minute penalty and pulled another one back in the 80th minute. With Maldon wobbling, only the bar denied the visitors a notable point but the Essex men held on to make it five home wins out of five.

Potters Bar retained the division's other unbeaten record but were held to a 1-1 home draw by **Heybridge**, a fair result on the day. Taylor Hastings gave Swifts the lead after 56 minutes and Sergio Manesio replied for the hosts 14 minutes later.

Overnight leaders **Tilbury** slipped to third after going down 1-0 at home to **Grays** in a predictably fiery local derby. Jake Hall's 31st-minute goal was enough to give Grays their first win at Chadfields for 26 years, and both sides had a man sent off for violent conduct in the second half, Joel Barnett of Tilbury and Danny Bunce of Grays. The crowd of 421 was the division's best of the season.

Cheshunt stayed well in the mix at the top with a comfortable 3-0 home win over **Ilford**. Tony Burke opened their account with a 34th-minute penalty and set up the second for Ryan Wade just before half-time. Lee Brennan added the third.

Aveley are hot on the heels of the top five after seeing off local rivals **Brentwood** by the same score at the Mill Field. Junior Dadson and an own goal by ex-Miller Ryan Doyle made it 2-0 by the 17th minute and Rashid Kamara added another well before the interval. Brentwood had Lee Blackburn sent off in the 83rd minute and Billy Holland wasted the chance to make it four with a late penalty.

There was a more important missed penalty at **Needham Market**, where Jake Whincup saved Sam Newson's kick and **Waltham Abbey** went home with a point from a goalless draw.

Soham are the comeback kings of the week. After their 6-3 victory at Harlow on Tuesday, having trailed three times, they wiped out a 2-0 half-time deficit to take all the points at **Romford**. Paul Clayton and Nick Reynolds scored in the last five minutes of the first half to put Romford in command but Rob Mason reduced the arrears early in the second period. Two goal in seven minutes by Matt Robinson put the visitors 3-2 up by the 63rd minute and that ended the scoring as Soham climbed into the top half of the table.

One Non-League Day disappointment was that the joint initiative by Aveley and Romford was not better rewarded. The two clubs, based less than a mile apart, staggered their kick-offs and offered discounted tickets covering both matches. It failed to pay off although, oddly enough, the attendance at both games was 104.

Harlow recovered from their midweek thrashing to pick up their first home points of the season at the fifth attempt. Always on top, they had to wait until the last eight minutes for the Gary Bowes double which provided a 2-0 win over **Wroxham**.

Thamesmead left it late to retain their 100 per cent home record. Only two minutes remained when Lea Dawson headed home a corner from Ashley Proberts for the only goal of their game against strugglers **Redbridge**.

Waltham Forest and **Sudbury** shared the spoils with a 2-2 draw at Cricklefield. Corey Whitely put Forest ahead after 32 minutes but Leon Antoine replied shortly before the interval and a deflected shot by Dave Cowley gave the visitors the lead with 20 minutes to go. Jack Leachman rescued the hosts in the 83rd minute.

It was a similar story at **Witham**, through here it was visiting **Chatham** who scored first only to fall behind before emerging with a 2-2 draw. Kevin Watson's header put Chats in front after 16 minutes and Witham hit back with two goals in five minutes of playing time either side of the interval, from Rob Whitnell and Danny Emmanuel. Brad Potter squared it in the 54th minute.

THE **Maidstone** public have responded with enthusiasm to the club's return to their home town after a long exile and a massive crowd of 1,989 poured into the Gallagher Stadium for the clash with **Dulwich** on Saturday.

It was the league's best crowd since April 2010, when 2,162 turned out to see Dartford presented with the Premier Division championship trophy and 2,134 watched a top-of-the table Division One South game between Folkestone and Croydon Athletic for which admission was free.

The fans – apart from those supporting Dulwich, of course - were well rewarded as they saw Stones power to a 5-0 victory. Alex Flisher and Shaun Welford got things moving with goals in the first nine minutes. The visitors missed their chance to get back into it when Junior Kadi's penalty was saved by Charlie Mitten, and Stones settled it with goals from Tom Mills and Flisher in the first three minutes after the interval. Welford nabbed his second midway through the half.

A hat-trick by Luke Blewden powered **Crawley Down** back to the top of the table with a stunning 5-1 win at in-form **Chipstead** who started the day in fourth place, just one point behind their guests.

Jamie Cade struck the first blow for the Anvils after four minutes and Baff Addae added another on 34 minutes. Blewden opened his account just before the interval and struck twice more after the break. James McShane managed a consolation effort for Chipstead, who skidded all the way down to 10th in this very tight division.

The top two at kick-off time both slumped to home defeats. Leaders **Folkestone** went down 3-1 at home to **Merstham**, for whom Mark Nwokeji looks to have been a valuable acquisition.

Jack Macleod gave the visitors a second-minute lead which was wiped out after half-time by Ryan Philpott. Nwokeji, whose promising Football League career with Dagenham was wrecked by a knee injury in 2009, then scored twice in three minutes soon after the hour.

Walton & Hersham slipped from second to fourth after a 2-0 home defeat by **Worthing**. The woodwork played a key role here: Scott Tipper's 23rd-minute opener for Worthing went in off a post and, after Scott Kirkwood made it 2-0 shortly before the interval, Gary Frewen and Graeme Purdy were both denied by the goal frame as the Swans tried to force their way back into the game.

Herne Bay are up to third after ramming in three unanswered goals at **Three Bridges** in the battle of the league newcomers. Rhys Lawson put them ahead midway through the first half, Dean Grant added another on the half-hour and James Turner wrapped it up ten minutes after the break.

Faversham are very much in the mix at the top after their 1-0 win at **Burgess Hill**, the only goal coming from Dan Lawrence soon after half-time.

Eastbourne, too, are well in contention. Danny Curd struck after six minutes in their 1-0 win at bottom club **Tooting**, who have scored only one home goal and failed to take a point in five games in front of their own fans.

Horsham moved away from the lower reaches of the table with a 2-0 home win over **Walton Casuals**. It's the first time they have won two league matches on the trot since the opening week of last season, when victories in successive away games at Kingstorian and Hornchurch was scant indication of the dismal season that was to follow. Gary Charman and Ryan Marriott were the men on target in the second half.

Leatherhead dropped to 21st place after their 2-1 home defeat by **Ramsgate** but it may be too early to despair. So tight are things that they are only seven points behind second-placed Folkestone with three games in hand. Tom Chapman hit a post for the visitors before Ashley Miller gave them a 36th-minute lead. Kev Terry replied for Tanners with 15 minutes left but there was no denying Chapman when he grabbed the winner five minutes from time.

Dave Cook was the hat-trick hero for **Hythe** in their 3-1 win at **Corinthian-Casuals**, who took an early lead through Jamie Byatt. Cook replied in the 13th minute and also hit the bar before putting his side ahead just before the half-hour mark. He completed his treble with 20 minutes left.

A Ryan Golding double gave **Sittingbourne** a 2-1 win at **Whitstable**. His 20th-minute opener brought an immediate response from Michael Smissen but the Oystermen had no comeback after Golding got his second with a 54th-minute penalty.
