Ryman Premier

SIX-HIT **Whitehawk** powered to the top of the table on Saturday as substitute Jefferson Louis helped himself to a hat-trick against an **Enfield Town** side reduced to nine men.

With Margate's game at Kingstonian one of six games in the division that fell victim to the weather, Hawks knew that a win would take them to the top. They had been in the same situation on Boxing Day but were held to a draw.

This time they made no mistake. Charlie Walker gave them a 12th-minute lead at East Brighton Park and Enfield suffered a double blow just before the half-hour when David Kendall was sent off for pulling back debutant Hakeem Araba, just signed from East Thurrock, and Paul Armstrong converted the penalty.

Enfield then held out until Craig McKay was sent off in the second half. Louis opened his account on 72 minutes and added two more in the closing stages, with Armstrong scoring his second in between them.

There was a sensational start to **Harrow**'s home game against **Cray**. It was only the second minute when Harrow keeper Elvijs Putnins launched a long clearance and watched it bounce over opposite number Andy Walker to put his side ahead.

Saheed Sankoh doubled the lead three minutes before half-time but Cray looked a different side after the break and a Paul Vines double levelled the scores by the 62nd minute. Danny Phillips netted from close range to put Cray in front with 15 minutes left, only for Simeon Akinola to make it 3-3 five minutes later.

Thurrock moved out of the relegation zone by completing a double over **Lewes** with a 2-1 victory in Sussex. Callum Donaghey, a new arrival from Three Bridges, headed a debut goal to put the home side ahead shortly before the interval but Danny Green equalised two minutes after the restart and Jon Dollery turned Stuart Thurgood's cross into his own net for the 68th-minute winner.

Wingate replace Thurrock in the bottom two after their 2-2 home draw with **Hastings**. Despite being reduced to ten men by David Laird's dismissal, Wingate opened the scoring soon after half-time through Dan Brown.

Hastings, a week away from their FA Cup trip to Middlesbrough, drew level in the 76th minute when Danny Ellis curled in a shot and went in front nine minutes later with a header from Bailo Camara.

Then Josh Jirbaney was sent off to level the numbers and Wingate salvaged a point in added time when Scott Shulton's corner found its way into the net.

Ryman North

A DEVASTATING display by **Heybridge** produced 11 unanswered goals and a league record against **Redbridge** at Scraley Road on Saturday.

Ben Newson started the rout in the fourth minute, Luke Callander made it 2-0 on 22 minutes and Newson quickly added his second. Then came a burst of three goals in five minutes, two from Michael Cheek and one from Callander.

Newson became the first of the trio to complete his hat-trick as he made it 7-0 right on half-time and Cheek got his third three minutes after the restart. It was Callander's turn in the 55th minute and he went one better with his fourth goal in the 65th minute, taking the total into double figures.

At that stage Ilford's 77-year-old league record of 15 goals was under threat but Swifts settled for one more, from Solomon Ofori in the 88th minute, and Redbridge almost had the last word when George Monger hit the bar.

Heybridge won 8-0 at Redbridge earlier in the season and the 19-0 'aggregate' was a league record. They just missed equalling another record: in the 1935-36 season Ilford beat Leytonstone 15-1 at home and 5-1 away. The haul of 20 goals against one opponent is an all-time best, but the aggregate margin was only 18.

There have been four 17-goal 'aggregate wins'. Hendon outscored Dulwich 19-2 (10-1 and 9-1) in 1963-64 and in 1993-94 it was done twice, both against the Croydon side who conceded 198 goals during the season. Berkhamsted beat them 14-1 and 4-0, and Staines scored 17 without reply (3-0 at home, 14-0 away).

Leatherhead followed up their 11-0 win at Horsham YMCA in 2010-11 with a 6-0 home victory for another 17-0 total.

That Leatherhead massacre was also the last double-figure score in the Ryman League. There have been 61 in all, included a 15 and two 14s (both mentioned above). St Albans and Lewes have both hit 13, Ilford and London Caledonians 12. Heybridge are the 19th team to score 11.

Clapton were the first team to reach double figures in the league when they beat Shepherds Bush 11-0 in 1909-10. They are also the only club to have been involved in ten double-figure matches: alas, they were on the receiving end in the other nine.

Callander also scored four of the eight at Redbridge. Newson got two and Cheek one after Jon Edwards had opened the scoring; so the terrible trio shared 17 successive goals against the Motormen. All have now reached the 20-goal mark for the season in league and FA competitions. Callander and Cheek have 21, Newson 20. Callander is now the top league scorer in any division with 19 and Cheek is in joint second place with 17. Newson has 15 in the league.

Second-placed Swifts are now the league's top scorers with 63 but they are still ten points behind neighbours Maldon, whose visit to Soham was one of six postponed matches in the division. Redbridge have let in 60 goals, the worst record in the league, but are two places off the bottom.

The day got off to a bad start for **Chatham** when both their goalkeepers reported sick. Winger Garry Tilley had to man the posts and could not prevent third-placed visitors **Grays** cruising to a 4-1 win.

Defender Junior Baker headed a sixth-minute opener and scored again in the 34th minute. Two in three minutes just after the hour from Jared Small and Joao Carlos made sure of the points before Liam Hickey managed a consolation.

Potters Bar edged back into the top five despite letting a 2-0 lead slip at home to **Needham Market** on a day of mixed fortunes for Boreham Wood loanee Harvey Scott-Morris.

He gave the Scholars an early lead and struck again with 20 minutes left. But Rhys Henry and Ollie Fenn levelled the scores and Scott-Morris was sent off in added time.

The **Sudbury** revival went on as they came from 2-0 down to beat **Harlow** 3-2 and make it ten points from four games which have lifted them into mid-table.

Hector Mackie struck twice in the first 16 minutes for the visitors. Leon Antoine pulled one back with a header six minutes before the interval, Tom Cutts equalised in the 73rd minute and Antoine won it with five minutes left.

Ryman South

A HAT-TRICK by Erhun Oztumer stretched **Dulwich**'s lead in Ryman South to four points yesterday (Saturday) with a 4-1 victory at **Worthing**.

It was the eighth defeat in 11 home games for the Rebels, who went ahead after 21 minutes through Jamie Brotherton. Oztumer responded with two goals in six minutes either side of the interval and Nyren Clunis converted a Kevin James pass to make it 3-1 on the hour. Oztumer completed his treble with seven minutes left.

Only four games were played in the division and they yielded three away wins and one draw. Visiting teams have had the upper hand in this division all season and they have now won 92 games, while home clubs have delighted their fans on only 76 occasions.

The most important of the other results came at **Chipstead**, where **Leatherhead**'s 2-0 win lifted them into fourth place. Chips had defender Josh Andrew sent off in the 20th minute and fell behind to a Kev Terry goal six minutes before the break. Mark Simmons made sure with 15 minutes left.

Horsham moved into the top half of the table with a 3-1 win at Tooting. After an exchange of penalties, with Tony Nwachukwu's effort for Horsham answered by Laurent Hamici, Scott Tipper headed the visitors into the lead for the second time moments before the interval. Tooting pressed for much of the second half before Charlie Farmer clinched it for Hornets in the last minute.

Ramsgate were the only home team to manage a point. Tom Parkinson scored his first goal since stepping up from the Kent League to give the hosts a 62nd-minute lead and Kai Bichard levelled it nine minutes later. The hosts had Gillingham loanee Ashley Miller sent off before the end.

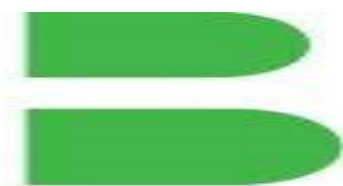
