MONTHLY AWARDS

WEEKEND REVIEW

The top three teams in the Premier Division all won, leaders Dover Athletic retaining their 25-point advantage over Staines Town after beating Hastings United 3–2 at the Crabble. Staines saw off Ramsgate 2–0 at Wheatsheaf Park to stay a point clear of Tonbridge Angels, the biggest winners of the day in the Division, 5–1 at bottom club Heybridge Swifts. Margate are now five points off the bottom, after a 2–0 defeat of Ashford Town (Middlesex) and are one of three teams on 25 points. Hendon, 2–1 losers at Wealdstone, and Harlow Town, who

drew 3–3 at home with Boreham Wood, are the other two. Sutton United's goalless draw at Canvey Island was enough for them to go above near neighbours Carshalton Athletic after the Robins went down 1–0 at another local club, Tooting & Mitcham United. Dartford are up to sixth after a 3–0 win at Horsham, while Billericay Town won an Essex derby against AFC Hornchurch, 1–0 at New Lodge. Maidstone United's match at home to Harrow Borough was postponed.

In Division One North, erstwhile leaders East Thurrock United's 2–2 draw at Wingate & Finchley allowed Aveley to return to the top after their 2–1 victory at Ware. Brentwood Town are just two points off the top, in third place, after winning 4–0 at relegation-threatened Hillingdon Borough. Two other teams threatened with relegation, Waltham Forest and Witham Town played each other, with Forest winning 1–0. The game between playoff rivals Waltham Abbey and Northwood was postponed, as were Maldon Town's trip to Redbridge and Potters Bar Town's home game against Great Wakering Rovers. Both Thamesmead Town and Tilbury enjoyed 3–0 home wins, seeing off Ilford and Cheshunt, respectively. The other two matches to be played ended draws, 0–0 between Leyton and Concord Rangers at Lea Bridge Road, and 1–1 at Chatham Town, where Enfield Town were the visitors.

In a day for draws in Division One South, Cray Wanderers missed out on the chance of joining Kingstonian at the top of the division, at least for 24 hours until Ks played Walton Casuals on Sunday, after they drew 0–0 at Croydon Athletic. Fleet Town needed a last-minute goal to secure a 2–2 draw at home to Sittingbourne, while Ashford Town, 1–1 at Dulwich Hamlet, and Metropolitan Police, 3–3 at home to Leatherhead, and Worthing, 1–1 at Chipstead, also shared the points. Merstham were top scorers as they inflicted a tenth straight League defeat, 4–0, on Crowborough Athletic, who are now 11 points behind their nearest rivals, Whitstable Town, despite the Oystermens' 3–2 home defeat against Eastbourne Borough. Corinthian–Casuals eased their relegation fears with a 2–0 victory at Goldalming Town. Burgess Hill Town defeat Folkestone Invicta 2–1 at Burroughs Park, while the other game, at Stompond Lane, went the way of Whyteleafe, who overcame hosts Walton & Hersham, 1–0.

In Sunday's Division One South match, Kingstonian their lead at the top to five points with a 4-2 defeat of Walton Casuals.

Premier Division

Dover Athletic survived a late scare to beat Hastings United. Laurence Ball opened the scoring after 28 minutes, but Frankie Sawyer levelled matters nine minutes later. Two goals in two minutes, from Giuliano Grazioli and Ollie Schultz, after 55 and 57 minutes, gave Dover breathing space, but Sawyer struck again with 18 minutes to go to set up a grandstand finish. Staines Town took the lead on the stroke of half-time against Ramsgate when Leroy Griffiths scored and the points were sealed by Richard Butler, eight minutes from time. Tonbridge Angels were grateful for a pair of penalties three minutes either side of half-time for their eventually comfortable win at Heybridge Swifts. Leon Legge had given the Angels the lead after 26 minutes, but James Robinson equalised five minutes before the interval. After the two Carl Rook penalties, James Westcott added number four after 55 minutes and Legge bagged his second after 72 minutes.

Visitors Sutton United held Canvey Island to a goalless draw at Park Lane, while a solitary, 80th-minute, goal, from Michael Antonio, gave Tooting & Mitcham United all three points from their local derby at Carshalton Athletic. An 81st-minute goal from Ashley Dumas gave Billericay Town all three points from their home game against AFC Hornchurch. There was

much less drama at Worthing, where Horsham suffered a 3–0 defeat against Dartford, Ryan Hayes opening the scoring after 23 minutes. Cody McDonald got the other two goals for the Darts, after 50 and 88 minutes. Two goals from Kenny Pratt, after 38 and 90 minutes, gave struggling Margate maximum points against Ashford Town (Middlesex) at Hartsdown Park.

A dramatic game at Grosvenor Vale saw Wealdstone win a fifth consecutive League encounter against Hendon, despite trailing to a Jamie Busby goal after eight minutes. Ryan Ashe equalised after 68 minutes and Greg Ngoyi netted the winner after 83 minutes. Both teams had penalties saved, taken by substitutes (Will Viner denying Ngoyi and Sean Thomas doing likewise against Brian Haule), and both had players dismissed – in separate incidents – in stoppage time. All the goalscoring action at Barrows Farm came in the second half as Harlow Town came from behind three times against Boreham Wood to draw 3–3. Wood took the lead through Chris Watters after 57 minutes, but Jamie Richards equalised four minutes later. Mario Noto restored their advantage after 75 minutes, and Wood held this advantage for ten minutes, when Richards struck again. In stoppage time, Sean Sonner gave the visitors a third lead but, two minutes later, John Frendo netted the Hawks' point-saver.

Maidstone United's match at home to Harrow Borough was postponed.

Division One North

The Division lead changed hands yet again as Richard Ketchell struck in the 88th minute at Wodson Park to give Aveley a 2–1 win against Ware. Tansel Ibrahim had give Ware a second-minute lead, but Ryan Doyle equalised midway through the second half. Previous leaders East Thurrock United trailed at Wingate & Finchley after only two minutes, Leon Nelson scoring. But they struck twice, through Martin Tuohy, 42 minutes, and Max Cornill, 62, only for Marvin Samuel to earn the home team a share of the points with an equaliser after 73 minutes. Brentwood Town had a comfortable 4–0 victory at strugglers Hillingdon Borough, Lee Perry scoring after 37 and 42 minutes, Sherwin Stanley after 48 and Donovan Wilson in the final minute.

First-half goals from Lewis Wood, Ricky Cable and Kevin George were enough for Thamesmead Town to defeat Ilford 3–0, and it was the same score at St Chad's Road, where

Manlee Brown struck after 22 and 69 minutes, and Joe Keith got the third after 84 minutes, Tilbury seeing off Cheshunt. Mike Ramkin scored the game's only goal with just four minutes to go to give Waltham Forest the points from their clash with fellow relegation-battlers Witham Town.

Goals by Lee Barnett, after 24 minutes, and Michael Deane, 31, for Chatham Town and Enfield Town, respectively ensured the two teams shared the spoils. There were no goals at Lea Bridge Road as Concord Rangers visited Leyton, while the games at Redbridge, Potters Bar Town and Waltham Abbey were all postponed, Maldon Town, Great Wakering Rovers and Northwood, respectively, the provisional visitors.

Division One South

All of the top seven to play entering Saturday drew. There were no goals at Croydon Athletic as second-placed Cray Wanderers could not join Kingstonian at the head of affairs. Jermaine Hamilton equalised in the last minute to save a point for Fleet Town, who had trailed twice at home to Sittingbourne. Richard Brady, three minutes, gave the Brickies an early lead, which was cancelled out by Mark Anderson eight minutes later. Joe Horlock notched Sittingbourne's second after 69 minutes. Junior Kaffo scored after 29 minutes for Dulwich Hamlet at home to Ashford Town, but Paul Jones levelled the game seven minutes into the second half. It also ended 1-1 at Chipstead, which Zak Graham giving the hosts a tenth-minute lead. Ross Treleven got Worthing's equaliser after 71 minutes.

There were six goals at Imber Court, where Leatherhead led 3-0 at half-time but had to settle for a share of the spoils. Stuart Hutchings scored after seven minutes and Jason Henry netted after 17 and 39 minutes, but Craig Brown, 55 minutes, Scott Forrester, 69, and Craig Carley, 76, replied for the Blues. Robert Smith scored the only goal of the game at Stompond Lane and it was enough for visiting Whyteleafe to beat Walton & Hersham. Burgess Hill Town scored ten minutes either side of half-time, through Lloyd Cotton and Steve Harper, against Folkestone Invicta's whose only reply came courtesy of James Dryden in the final three minutes.

There was a cracker at Whitstable Town, who thought they had taken all three points from Eastbourne Town when Liam Quinn added to his 28th-minute strike with a second goal, 11

minutes from time. But Liam Baitup, who had equalised after 53 minutes, netted a stoppage time winner, this after Luke Denton had grabbed a second equaliser two minutes from the end of normal time. There were also two late goals at Godalming Town and visiting Corinthian-Casuals took all three points thanks to 83rd and 90th minute goals from Matt Powell.

Crowborough Athletic suffered a tenth consecutive Ryman League defeat at home to Merstham, conceding four without reply. Kevin Lock got the after 35 minutes, and saw his shot deflected into the net for the second goal, two minutes later. Gaving Gordon made it three goals in five minutes when he scored and Kwebana Agyei completed the Crows misery 15 minutes from full-time.

On a damp Sunday afternoon at Kingsmeadow, Kingstonian were given an early shock by Walton Casuals who raced into a 2-0 lead inside 14 minutes with goals from Nana Badu and Liam Grier. But the Ks hit back after the break and Bobby Traynor and Carl Wilson-Dennis score after 51 and 52 minutes to level things. Wilson-Dennis got his second and Tommy Williams completed the scoring with two goals in a minute just past the hour mark as Kingstonian ran out 4-2 winners.

Ryman Youth League

Four matches escaped the wet weather this week, with Croydon Athletic's youth team moving to the top of the South East Division following their 5-2 win at Whyteleafe.

Whilst that was the only game played in the South East Division, two games were successfully staged in the North West Division. Hampton & Richmond Borough also won by a 5-2 margin, this time at home, against Carshalton Athletic, whilst Tooting & Mitcham United beat Corinthian-Casuals 2-0 at The Hub.
