Amazingly, 11 out of 31 matches survived one of the coldest and snowiest weeks in recent memory. While all of the games in Division One North fell by the wayside, seven games in the Premier Division and Four in Division One South went ahead. Congratulations must go

out to all the groundsmen and other volunteers who spent hours in getting their clubs' pitches playable.

In the Premier Division, the top two Dover Athletic and Staines Town both scored three times at home in victories, Hendon failing to score at the Crabble and Sutton United getting just one at Wheatsheaf Park. Margate moved above both Hendon and Harrow Borough – 3–1 losers at Canvey Island – beating Tooting & Mitcham United 2–0, while Heybridge Swifts are now four points adrift at the bottom, despite collecting a point from their goalless draw at home to Dartford. Ramsgate remain just outside the bottom four after their 1–0 defeat at Horsham. The other match, at the Bourne Ground ended in a 1–1 draw, visitors Boreham Wood collecting a point against Maidstone United.

In Division One South, Metropolitan Police climbed back to second in the table, a point behind Kingstonian, with a 2–1 victory over Folkestone Invicta. Worthing went up one place, into the last of the playoff positions, with a 1–1 draw at Burgess Hill Town. Leatherhead and Whitstable Town both ended recent poor runs of form with victories against team also in the bottom half-dozen. The Tanners heaped more misery on Crowborough Athletic, winning 4–0 away, while the Oystermen saw off Corinthian–Casuals 3–2 at home.

Premier Division

Dover Athletic Chairman Jim Parmenter arrived at The Crabble at 7.30 on Saturday morning to help clear the pitch of snow. Only 0.25 inches fell on the ground on Friday night – the first snow in that part of Kent all week – while a village just a couple of miles away copped three inches. It meant the ground clearing work was done very quickly and it was almost as simple for the Whites when they met Hendon at 3.00 pm. Goals by Sammy Moore and Shaun Welford after 37 and 41 minutes put them in the driving seat and Frannie Collin sealed the points with a third goal 11 minutes from time. Dover continue to lead the Division by 23 points as Staines Town got goals from Howard Newton, 19 minutes, Scott Taylor 24, and Leroy Griffiths, 88, to see off Sutton United, who had led through David Hughes' goal after ten minutes.

It also ended 3–1 at Park Lane, where Canvey Island got all their goals in the first half, courtesy of Leon Gordon, three minutes, Gabriel Fanibuyan, 25, and Chris Moore, 38. Harrow Borough pulled a back through Jonathan Constant in the first minute of the second half, but that was a close as they got. A solitary goal, from Reggie Savage after 79 minutes, was enough for Horsham to defeat Ramsgate at Worthing, Margate scored in the first and last two minutes of the second half – Wayne Wilson and Ryan Peters the marksmen – to beat Tooting & Mitcham United at Harstdown Park.

The other two matches ended all square, Jon Wordsworth of Boreham Wood netting after 72 minutes to cancel out hosts Maidstone United's opener from Lloyd Blackman, a 50th-minute penalty. And there were no goals at Scraley Road, where Heybridge Swifts entertained Dartford.

Division One South

Top scorers of the day were Leatherhead, who hit four without reply at Crowborough Athletic.

John Cartledge opened the scoring after 58 minutes, followed seven minutes later Kev Terry, the first of his two goals on the afternoon. Jason Henry got number three with 20 minutes to go and Terry wrapped up scoring in the last five minutes. Corinthian–Casuals equalised twice at Whitstable Town, but still came away empty handed. Jack Tanner scored for the Oystermen after 12 minutes, only for Jemal Carr to reply after 28. Dave Cory restored Whitstable's advantage eight minutes after the resumption, but the lead lasted only five minutes before Chris Horwood restored parity. But Cory was match-winner, scoring his second goal 15 minutes from the final whistle.

Metropolitan Police kept up their promotion push with a victory over Folkestone Invicta. Steve Sargent scored after 25 and 42 minutes to give the Blues a clear advantage. But, with 11 minutes to go, Folkestone were awarded a penalty, taken by James Dryden, but saved by Mo Maan. Dryden, however, knocked the rebound into the net to make it 2–1, which is how the game stayed. At Burroughs Park, Ben Andrews gave Worthing the lead seven minutes into the second half. Burgess Hill Town collected a point when Jon Lansdale equalised nine minutes from time.

METROPOLITAN POLICE FC

The Metropolitan Police Football Club were saddened on Monday 26th January 2009 with the news of the death of John Somerville, a former Divisional footballer, and respected General Manager, Treasurer and Vice Chairman of the Football Club, aged 78 years.

John Somerville joined the Metropolitan Police Force on 1 February 1954 aged 23 years and was posted to Bow Street Police Station on E Division. He had been a keen sportsman excelling at athletics and football whilst at school and during his National Service. John soon established himself in the Bow Street Police football team and the E Divisional team. After 5 years he was promoted to Sergeant and due to family commitments he could not commit himself to playing twice a week in Police domestic football. Instead he made steady and regular promotions through the ranks and made it his duty to give all the support he possibly could to the officers at the Stations he served.

Towards the end of the 1960's John came to notice as an avid Metropolitan Police Football Club supporter along with his wife Diana. On 13th July 1972 at the Annual General Meeting of the Football Club, John as an Inspector was appointed the first General Manager of the Club. Further promotions resulted in John as a Chief Superintendent in 1980 being appointed Treasurer of the Club. John continued to travel to the majority of the Club matches both home and away and also assisted in the organisation of the football club lottery.

In July 1982 John was appointed a Vice Chairman of the Club a position he held until he retired aged 54 from the Service on 9th September 1985. Throughout the long period that he was involved with the Club he was very active, conscientious, dedicated and extremely hard working as well as being well liked and respected by all those he came into contact with.

In his retirement John Somerville along with his wife Diana continued to attend matches both at home and away and offer advice and their services to the Club whenever needed.

John Somerville died on Monday 26th January 2009 in St Anthony's Hospital, Cheam from bronchopneumonia. He fought his long illness bravely and such was his love and dedication for the Club, on occasions when unable to walk, his wife Diana would drive him through the gates at the Football Club Ground and park against the far boundary wall where he would be able to watch the match from the front passenger seat.

The Metropolitan Police Football Club offers its deepest condolences to his widow Diana and his two daughters Carole and Fran and other members of his family.

The Funeral will take place on Tuesday 10th February 2009 at 2pm at North East Surrey Crematorium, Lower Morden Lane, Morden, Surrey SM4 4NJ
