WEEKEND REVIEW

Dover Athletic are now guaranteed at least a top-two finish after they drew 1–1 at Tooting & Mitcham United and third-placed Tonbridge Angels slipped up 1–0 at home to AFC Hornchurch. Staines Town remain second after they won 2–0 at strugglers Harlow Town. Sutton United are back up to fourth after they won 2–0 at bottom-placed Heybridge Swifts, while fellow strugglers Ramsgate earned a point at fifth-placed Carshalton Athletic, the match ending 3–3. In the relegation battle of the day, Harrow Borough beat Hendon 4–2, sending the Greens back down to 21st. Margate rose a place on the back of their 2–2 draw at Dartford. Ashford Town (Middlesex) are looking nervously over their shoulders after a 1–0 defeat at home to Boreham Wood. And it is the same story with Hastings United, 1–0 losers at Billericay Town. Both Wealdstone's visit to Canvey Island and Horsham's trip to Maidstone United ended in 1–1 draws.

LEAGUE NEWS

East Thurrock United remain top of Division One North, having gone to the head of affairs in midweek, after they won 3–2 at Thamesmead Town. Aveley remain a point behind after they won 1–0 at Great Wakering Rovers but Brentwood Town and Northwood, in third and four spots, after they drew 1–1 at Chatham Town and 0–0 at home to Redbridge, respectively. Rounding out the top five are Waltham Abbey, 1–0 winners at Ilford. Hillingdon Borough stay adrift at the bottom, but they cut the gap on Witham Town to nine points after a 3–3 at Potters Bar Town. Witham, meanwhile, went down 2–0 at Enfield Town and are now eight points adrift of Waltham Forest, who picked up an excellent point from a 1–1 draw at Tilbury. Maldon Town's 2–0 defeat at Leyton means they are not quite out of the woods yet although they are 11 points clear of the relegation zone. Concord Rangers and Wingate & Finchley are just outside the playoff places after they both scored four times in victories, the Essex club winning 4–2 at Ware, Wingate & Finchley seeing off Cheshunt 4–1 at the Abrahams Stadium.

Cray Wanderers, who opened up a three-point lead on the chasing pack last midweek, doubled their advantage with a 3–1 win at Folkestone Invicta. Kingstonian were shocked 1–0 at home by Corinthian-Casuals, who remain in the bottom two but are only a point from safety. The playoff situation remains very

cloudy with Ks, in second place, only four points clear of Ashford Town in eighth, though the former have played fewer games than the rest of the Division. Worthing are third after they drew 1–1 with Whyteleafe, and they are ahead of Metropolitan Police, 1–0 losers at Godalming, only on goal difference. Fleet Town's 2–2 draw at home to Croydon Athletic leaves them in sixth, a point and a place behind Sittingbourne. Merstham's playoff hopes were dented by Ashford, who won 3–0 at the Homelands. Burgess Hill Town rose above Chipstead into 19th position after drawing 1–1 at home to Walton & Hersham, while the Chips were going down 3–1 at home to Sittingbourne. In the light of their 2–0 defeat at Eastbourne Town, Crowborough Athletic's position looks forlorn, 17 points behind the Casuals, with only ten games to play. Walton Casuals eased their relegation worries with a 1–0 victory over Leatherhead, while there was a goalless stalemate at Whitstable Town, where Dulwich Hamlet were the visitors.

Premier Division

Frannie Collin's 85th-minute penalty at Imperial Fields brought Dover Athletic a 1–1 draw against Tooting & Mitcham United. The Terrors had taken the lead six minutes earlier through Paul Vines. Both Staines Town and Sutton United won 2–0 away, Marien Ifura, 44 minutes, and Richard Butler, 70, netting for Staines at Harlow Town, while debutant Laurent Hamici and Craig Dundas, after 10 and 55 minutes, respectively scored for Sutton at Heybridge Swifts. Staines and Sutton are separated in the table by Tonbridge Angels, who went down 1–0 at home to AFC Hornchurch, for whom Dean Green was on target midway through the second half.

Solitary goals were also enough for Boreham Wood – Mario Noto netting after 24 minutes – at Ashford Town (Middlesex) and Billericay Town – Lynvall Duncan finding the target in the second minute – at home to Hastings United. There were also two other 1–1 draws: At Park Lane, Lee Chappell gave visiting Wealdstone the lead after 28 minutes, but Jay Curran salvaged a point for Canvey Island 13 minutes from the end; at the Bourne Ground, James Pinnock gave Maidstone United the lead after 60 minutes, but Horsham's Claude Seania hit back four minutes later.

The other three games produced 16 goals. Hendon had no answer to Harrow Borough's Gary Noel, who bagged a four-timer, scoring after 3, 27, 65 and 90 minutes. The Greens

did equalise twice, through James Parker, six minutes, and Jamie Busby, 54. At the War Memorial Stadium, it was thrust and counter-thrust. Ramsgate's Jay May opened the scoring from the penalty spot after 17 minutes, only for Carshalton Athletic's Charlie Ide to equalise within a minute. Bash Alimi gave the Robins the lead after 28 minutes, but it lasted only two minutes as Steffan Ball made it 2–2. In the 80th minute, Richard Jolly put Carshalton ahead again, but the Rams snatched a point seven minutes later with a goal from Simon Pettit. At Hartsdown Park, Dartford's Tommy Osbourne scored at both ends, for Margate after 39 minutes and for the Darts, from the penalty spot, on the hour mark. Kenny Pratt put Margate ahead for the second time after 67 minutes, but Adam Gross made it 2–2 11 minutes later.

Division One North

Two goals from Thamesmead Town's Lee Dawson, after 20 and 35 minutes, were not enough to overcome visiting leaders East Thurrock United. Martin Tuohy pulled one goal back four minutes before half-time and Ben Boyce equalised with 15 minutes to go. In the final minute, Martin Llewellyn snatched a winner for the Rocks. A solitary goal, by Sean Francis after 40 minutes, was enough for Aveley to take maximum points from their visit to Great Wakering Rovers. Third-placed Brentwood Town trailed to an 80th minute goal from Chatham Town's Lee Barnett, but they hit back two minutes later, substitute Sam Higgins rescuing a point. But there were no goals at Chestnut Avenue, where Northwood, in fourth spot, entertained Redbridge.

Two early goals, from Ellis Remy, three minutes, and Billy Healey, 14, were enough for Enfield Town to beat Witham Town at Wodson Park, while Aaron Gayle's 14th-minute effort for Waltham Abbey gave them the points at Ilford. Robert Carter scored both of Leyton's goals, after 33 and 53 minutes, as they recorded a 2–0 home victory over Maldon Town. Tilbury took a first half lead against Waltham Forest at St Chad's Road, Joe Keith converting a 28th-minute penalty. But Tony Fraser earned the visitors a point with his goal just past the hour mark.

Bottom club Hillingdon Borough rescued a point in the final minute of their visit to Potters Bar Town. The Scholars took the lead through Sam Adejokun just before half-time, and extended their advantage just after the break, courtesy of Reece Wilson. But another Reece, Chaudri pulled a goal back for Borough

after 53 minutes, only for Wilson to make it 3–1 on the hour. Lucas Williams halved the deficit with 15 minutes to go and Chaudri made it 3–3 at the death. There was no such drama at the Abrahams Stadium, where Wingate & Finchley raced into a three-goal lead through Bobby Aisien, 27 minutes, Leon Nelson, 40 and Ahmet Rifat, 71. David Pidgeon did pull a goal back for Cheshunt after 79 minutes but, five minutes later, Rifat bagged his second, to seal a 4–1 victory.

At Wodson Park, Concord Rangers led hosts Ware early, but had to stage a late rally to win 4–2. Elliot Buchanan gave Concord the lead after five minutes, but Ware levelled through Darryl Wilson after 34 minutes and led courtesy of Tansel Ibrahim two minutes into the second half. Back came Concord and they equalised through Nick Skelton after 60 minutes. Danny Heale restored their lead with 12 minutes to go and Buchanan scored his second two minutes later.

Division One South

Cray Wanderers stretched their lead at the top of the table with a 3–1 victory at the Buzzlines Stadium, Folkestone. Jamie Wood gave the Wands the lead after 27 minutes, and it was extended by Scott Kinch, 47 minutes, and Steve Aris, 58, before Frankie Chappell netted a consolation two minutes from the end. Kingstonian trailed to a goal from Corinthian–Casuals Martin Dunne after just four minutes and that's how the game ended. It was the same score at Walton Casuals, where Michael Barima was the home team's match-winner after 47 minutes against Leatherhead, and at Godalming Town, where Graham Purdy's 33rd-minute goal beat the Metropolitan Police.

Ashford Town's Shawn Beaveney scored a hat-trick, after eight, 36 and 69 minutes, and it was all they needed to beat fellow promotion hopefuls Merstham 3–0. Sittingbourne are right in the promotion playoff hunt after their 3–1 victory at Chipstead. Mark DeBolla's penalty after 34 minutes set them on their way and Richard Brady, 42 minutes and Mark Green, 64, made it 3–0, before Nathan Campbell netted the Chips' consolation in the last ten minutes. Arriving three minutes late and leaving three minutes early at Burgess Hill Town would have left spectators thinking they had watched a 0–0 draw. In fact Walton & Hersham had led after two minutes through Julian Owusu-Bekoe and the Hillians snatched a point with Zac Beda's 89th-minute reply. There wasn't as much drama at The Saffrons as a Thom Newell own goal and another strike

from Jamie Salvidge brought Eastbourne Town all three points against Crowborough Athletic.

It ended all square at Fleet Town as Croydon Athletic equalised in the dying moments. The visitors led through Danny Waldren after 18 minutes, but Nathan Smart and Ben Smith turned it around for Fleet in the nine minutes before half-time. But in the final minute, Ben Godfrey popped up with Croydon's point-saver. It also ended all square at Whitstable Town, where neither they, nor Dulwich Hamlet could break the deadlock. At the A2B Stadium, Lee Farrell gave hosts Worthing the lead after 70 minutes, but Whyteleafe earned a point when Robert Smith netted two minutes from time.

Ryman Youth League

The two Ryman Youth League matches played this week saw the top team in the two Divisions stretch their lead by a further three points.

On Monday evening, the South East Division leaders Croydon Athletic won with the only goal of the match on their visit to Eastbourne Town – Jack Nicholson scoring the all important goal after just two minutes.

On Thursday evening, Staines Town, top of the North West Division, won 4-0 at home to Kingstonian, Alfie Arthur and Ryan Ford notching two apiece.

With five Youth League matches postponed due to the adverse weather conditions, the rest of the action was confined to the Isthmian Youth Cup. The final two Second Round matches were completed, with Tonbridge Angels winning 3-1 at home to Folkestone Invicta, and holders Leatherhead moving through to the Third Round following their 5-2 win at Horsham YNCA, although needing extra time to achieve their victory.

In the Third Round on Wednesday evening, there were home wins for two Essex clubs. Billericay Town beat Thamesmead Town 4-2, whilst Brentwood Town had a clear 4-0 victory against the youngsters from Leyton.
