LEAGUE NEWS

Dover Athletic have led the Premier Division all season by a clear points distance, and on the last Saturday of March, they deservedly clinched the Championship with a stunning 6-0 winning margin at home to play-off rivals Sutton United. This performance has therefore won the Kent club the ‘Premier Division Team Performance’ award for the month of March.

Tilbury’s fortunes this season have steadily improved under the guidance of their new management team led by Graham Chester, and on Tuesday evening, 17th March, they beat Premier Division neighbours Billericay Town 2-0 to reach the Final of the Isthmian League Cup competition for the first time since 1976. This was their third success against Premier Division opposition in the Cup this season, and won Tilbury their second ‘Division One North Team Performance’ award of the season.

Corinthian-Casuals, sitting in 21st position in Division One South at the time, travelled to top of the table Kingstonian on Saturday, 7th March, and after ninety minutes play, returned home with the three points from a gallant and unexpected 1-0 victory. The win has therefore won the Club the Team Performance award for Division One South for March.

WEEKEND REVIEW

Premier Division champions Dover Athletic were nearly embarrassed at relegation threatened Heybridge Swifts but escaped with a 1–1 draw. Their nearest rivals Staines Town, also drew, 0–0 at home to Tooting & Mitcham United, but third-placed Tonbridge Angels made no mistake, hammering Hendon 5–1. Sutton United remained fourth after a solitary-goal victory over Dartford at Gander Green Lane, their near neighbours Carshalton Athletic are back in the playoff positions after an identical victory at Canvey Island. Ramsgate fate is almost confirmed after they lost 2–1 at home to Harlow Town, who climbed to 15th with the victory. Margate, however remain deep in trouble following their 3–2 loss at Harrow Borough, who are now almost safe. Boreham Wood's 2–2 draw at Horsham lifted them out of the drop zone at the expense of Hendon, but only seven points separate Hendon from 11th spot. Billericay Town and

Ashford Town (Middlesex) are in that group of nine clubs and it was the former who beat the latter, 2–0, at New Lodge. Hastings United surprised AFC Hornchurch 2–1 at Bridge Avenue, while Wealdstone were knocked out of the playoff spots by Maidstone United, 2–1 at the Bourne Ground.

East Thurrock United returned to the top of Division One North, their late equaliser at home to Concord Rangers being their 100th League goal of the season, the first club to reach that mark this season. Aveley fell to second after losing 3–1 at home to third-placed Brentwood Town, but nine points still separate the top two and the field. Waltham Abbey beat Ware 3–0 and Northwood went two better at home to Witham Town and they round out the top five. Redbridge and Wingate & Finchley still have playoff hopes although they both slipped up 1–0, the former at Chatham Town, the latter at home to Leyton. The bottom two are almost guaranteed after Ilford moved 12 points clear of Witham Town with their 1–0 defeat of already doomed Hillingdon Borough at Cricklefield Stadium. Immediately above the Foxes, Waltham Forest moved to within a point of Potters Bar Town after beating them 2–0 away. Maldon Town won 3–0 at Cheshunt, while Great Wakering Rovers got a late winner to see off Enfield Town 2–1. The other match, at Thamesmead Town, where Tilbury were the visitors, ended goalless.

Kingstonian now appear favourites for automatic promotion from Division One South after they won 2–0 at Folkestone Invicta. They are level on points with Cray Wanderers - 4–1 victors at home to Corinthian-Casuals – two clear of Fleet Town, 2–0 winners at Chipstead, and six points up on both Metropolitan Police and Worthing. The Blues were held to a 1–1 draw by Sittingbourne at Imber Court, while the Rebels slipped up 2–0 at Ashford Town. The Brickies are still four points behind Worthing and they both have four games to play. Merstham remain seventh despite losing 3–1 at Walton Casuals. At the bottom, Crowborough Athletic suffered their 31st League defeat, 5–1 at Dulwich Hamlet, but Burgess Hill Town moved above Chipstead after they beat Whyteleafe 2–0 at Leylands Park. And there were away wins for Croydon Athletic, 2–1 at Godalming Town, Eastbourne Town, 1–0 at Leatherhead, Walton & Hershaw, 2–1 at Whitstable Town.

Premier Division

Ben Codling gave Heybridge Swifts a surprise lead after 11 minutes at home to Dover Athletic. But the champions salvaged a point with Shaun Welford's goal 20 minutes from time. There were no goals at all at Wheatsheaf Park, where Staines Town were held by Tooting & Mitcham United. Top scorers in the Division on Saturday were Tonbridge Angels, who hit five against Hendon. Scott Gooding scored after nine and 32 minutes, followed by Anthony Storey, 41, Carl Rook, 58, and Dwain Clark, 88. Hendon's only response was an 82nd-minute penalty from Jamie Busby. The Greens drop back into the bottom four.

Ramsgate are now four points adrift at the bottom after losing 2–1 at home to fellow strugglers Harlow Town. Luke Coleman gave them a 15th-minute from the penalty spot, but the Hawks hit back with goals from Jamie Richards, 62 minutes, and Michael Bardle, 85. Two Matt MacLean goals for Hastings United, either side of Mark Janney's strike for AFC Hornchurch, gave the Sussex club a vital 2–1 victory in Essex. Billericay also eased their relegation fears with a 2–0 home defeat of Ashford Town (Middlesex), another club in trouble. Joe Flack opened the scoring after 52 minutes, and Ide Okojie completed the victory in the last six minutes.

Harrow Borough came from 2–0 down at half-time to beat Margate at Earslmead. Kenny Pratt and Luke Wheatley scored in the first and last minutes of the first half, Ryan Watts and Gary Noel restored parity within seven minutes of the resumption and Tobi Jinadu grabbed the winner after 69 minutes. Richard Jolly was Carshalton Athletic's match-winner at Canvey Island, scoring the only goal after 82 minutes. And Steve Watts converted a penalty after 83 minutes, to give Sutton United a 1–0 victory at home to Dartford.

Two Meshach Nugent goals, after 11 and 61 minutes, were enough for Maidstone United to win the battle of 1980s Conference Champions. Wealdstone's response was 14th minute equaliser from Greg Ngoyi. And Sean Sonner also scored twice, for Boreham Wood at Horsham. His goals – after 31 and 68 minutes - cancelled out strikes by Anthony Acheampong, 20 minutes, and Steve Davies, 56.

Division One North

East Thurrock United returned to the top of the table, when Martin Tuohy netted an 87th-

minute equaliser at home to Concord Rangers, who had led for 11 minutes, courtesy of Anthony Cook. Erstwhile leaders Aveley slipped up 3–1 at home to third-placed Brentwood, who got two goals from Sherwin Stanley, after 15 and 45 minutes, and a third from Sam Higgins, 69. Neil Richmond had brought Aveley back into the game after 55 minutes. Waltham Abbey remain in fourth place after Arron Gayle, three minutes, Harry Elmes, nine, and Michael Sharman gave them a 3–0 home victory against Ware.

Northwood were the Division's top scorers, hitting five without reply at home to Witham Town. Eugene Ofori, after 14 and 60 minutes, Gary Senior, 39, a Bradley Stopher own goal (49) and Gary Burrell were the scorers. Wingate & Finchley slipped up again, Junior Luke's goal after 41 minutes giving Leyton a 1–0 away victory. And Redbridge's playoff hopes were also dented 1–0 at Chatham, where Lee Barnett scored after 71 minutes. Another Barnett, Maldon Town's Joel was his team last goalscorer as they won 3–0 at Cheshunt. He scored after 12 minutes, following strikes from Ross Parmenter and Chris Day after six and eight minutes, respectively.

In the basement battle, a fourth-minute goal from Wesley Hause was enough to give Ilford a 1–0 victory at home to Hillingdon Borough. Fervour Gariga gave Waltham Forest the lead after 33 minutes at Potters Bar Town and Yacine Hamada made sure of the points with a second goal soon after the interval. All the goals at Burroughs Park came in the second half as Great Wakering Rovers beat Enfield Town 2–1 Dan Trenkel gave the home team the lead after 55 minutes, Marcel McKie equalised 18 minutes later, but Friskin Rishiti scored the winner four minutes from time. And there were no goals when Tilbury visited Thamesmead Town.

Division One South

Bobby Traynor scored after 21 minutes and Adam Thompson got a second ten minutes later to give Kingstonian a 2–0 victory at Folkestone Invicta. Lewis Wood bagged a hat-trick, scoring after one, 67 and 71 minutes to help Cray Wanderers to a 4–1 win at home to Corinthian-Casuals. Leigh Bremner scored the Wands' other goal before half-time, while Saheed Sankoh netted a late consolation for the visitors. Darren Wheeler, 56 minutes, and Darren Campbell, 81, were on target for Fleet Town as they won 2–0 at relegation-threatened Chipstead. Gary Drewett gave

Metropolitan Police the lead after 59 minutes at home to Sittingbourne, but the Brickies drew level with Joe Horlock's effort 13 minutes from time.

Worthing lost ground on the top three after Paul Jones, 14 minutes, and Tony Browne, 30, gave Ashford Town victory at The Homelands. At the other end of the table, Burgess Hill Town won by the same margin at home to Whyteleafe, Steve Harper and Wes Tate netting in the final 20 minutes. Scott Simpson and Danny Francis both scored one in each half as Dulwich Hamlet piled on the misery for Crowborough Athletic. Darryl Plummer also netted in the second half for the Hamlet, while the Crows' only response came from Scott Treleaven when it was already 5-0. Godalming Town took the lead at home to Croydon Athletic when Glen Stanley scored after 25 minutes. But Ben Godfrey equalised seven minutes later and Karl Murray grabbed the winner 15 minutes from the end.

James Norwood scored the only of the game after 12 minutes and it was enough for Eastbourne Town to take all three points from Leatherhead. Two goals from Nick Burton gave Walton Casuals a 2-1 half-time lead against Merstham, who had led through Gavin Gordon after ten minutes. Patrick Darnali got Casuals' third in the last minute. Whitstable Town also took an early lead, Dave Corey scoring in the first minute at home to Walton & Hersham. But the Oysterman ended up pointless as the Swans drew level through Scott Hassell after 13 minutes, and won the game with a goal from Danny Green nine minutes into the second half.

Ryman Youth League

Second played top in the South East Division of the Ryman Youth League on Monday evening when Lewes entertained Croydon Athletic. And after ninety minutes play there was no change with the two team playing out a hard fought goalless draw, leaving Lewes five points behind the Athletic but with four games in hand.

Tonbridge Angels moved up to third place following their two wins and six points secured, and are now just one point behind Lewes, and having played the same number of games. On Monday evening they had a 4-1 home win against visitors Eastbourne Town, whilst on Thursday they returned home from a visit to basement team Horsham YMCA with a 3-1 win.

Also playing Monday evening by the seaside were Worthing and Whyteleafe, with the hosts Worthing winning 3-0. On Thursday evening Eastbourne Town were on the end of their second 1-4 defeat of the week, this time losing at home to Burgess Hill Town. The final match was at Horsham on Thursday evening, where unfortunately their game with Maidstone United had to be abandoned after 75 minutes with the score at 1-1 following a serious leg break to Horsham's Tom Hoole.

In the North West Division, Woking and Corinthian-Casuals opened up the week on Wednesday with away wins at Godalming Town and Walton & Hersham respectively. Woking won 2-1 at Godalming, whilst the Casuals won their second game of the season at Walton 3-0.

On Thursday evening Carshalton Athletic were the third team in the Division to record an away win as they beat Tooting & Mitcham United 4-1. This left second placed AFC Wimbledon to record the solitary home win in the North West, as they beat Kingstonian 3-1, moving just five points behind leaders Staines Town, and the two clubs still have to meet this season.

If students want to study at university, play semi-professionally or take-up coaching and travel abroad, we can provide them with opportunities to do so. One thing for sure is that expectations and standards will be high".
