LEAGUE NEWS

WEEKEND REVIEW

Only three matters were confirmed on the final Saturday of the season: Harlow Town will finish in the Premier Division bottom three, Kingstonian are champions of Division One South and Chipstead will finish in the bottom two of that Division. The result of the day also came in this section, Crowborough Athletic winning for the first time since 9 November, their 1 – 0 defeat of Cray Wanderers arguably being the result of the season in the Ryman League.

In the Premier Division, Dover Athletic returned to winning ways, beating Wealdstone 3–1, a result that leaves the Middlesex club out of the playoff picture and makes Dover the only Ryman club to pass 100 points this season. Temporarily, at least, that is also the case with Sutton United, who went down 2–0 at Margate, giving the Kent club hope that they still might escape the bottom four. Staines Town, 3–2 losers at Heybridge Swifts, have now gone nine games without a victory. But both Carshalton Athletic and AFC Hornchurch climbed above Sutton with their victories, 3–1 at home to Harlow and 3–0 at home to Horsham, respectively. Tonbridge Angels won 3–2 at Harrow and they will definitely finish third. At the bottom, Boreham Wood's 1–1 draw at Billericay Town leaves them just a point clear of the bottom four, while Hendon, who went down 2–1 at Hastings United are only a point better off, but the Greens' positive goal difference is worth a point, so they need

just one from their last two matches to be certain avoiding the bottom four. Ashford Town (Middlesex) netted in the last minute to see off Maidstone United 1–0, while Dartford hammered Ramsgate 4–0 at Princes Park.

East Thurrock United have moved into pole position for automatic promotion from Division One North after they won 4–1 at Waltham Forest and nearest rivals Aveley were held to a 1–1 home draw by Maldon Town. The two meet this Saturday at Rookery Hill. Brentwood Town will finish third and they won 3–1 at Cheshunt. Waltham Abbey will finish fourth despite losing 1–0 at Chatham Town, but the last playoff place will go down to the final round of matches. Northwood, who won 1–0 at home to Great Wakering Rovers, have played a game more than Concord Rangers – 1–0 winners at home to Hillingdon Borough – but the Essex club's game in hand is against another top-eight team, Redbridge, who lost 1–0 at home to Ware. Wingate & Finchley moved up to seventh with their 3–1 victory over Thamesmead Town. Witham Town scored twice in the last five minutes to snatch a 3–3 draw at home to Leyton, but they will finish in 21st place. Ilford moved out of the bottom four with their 1–0 victory at Enfield Town. League Cup winners Tilbury won again, beating Potters Bar Town 3–2 at Chadfields.

In the Division One South Kingstonian received the Champion's trophy after beating Dulwich Hamlet 2–1. Cray's defeat is mentioned earlier, and whilst they are certainly in the playoffs, their final position is not certain. Fleet Town – 2–0 winners at home to Folkestone Invicta and Metropolitan Police – winners by the same score at Burgess Hill Town – are both definitely in the playoffs, and Worthing, despite losing 2–1 at home to Croydon Athletic, are likely to join them. Sittingbourne are three points behind the Rebels after the Brickies won 3–1 at home to Whyteleafe, but the goal difference considerably favours Worthing. By losing 4–2 at Godalming Town, Chipstead will finish in the bottom two. Of the bottom six, only Crowborough picked up any points. Corinthian-Casuals lost 2–1 at Merstham, whilst Walton Casuals went down in the same fashion at home to Whitstable Town. Walton & Hersham and Leatherhead played out a goalless draw at Stompond Lane and Ashford Town won 2–0 at Eastbourne Town.

Premier Division

Champions Dover Athletic passed the 100-point mark as Matt Fish, four minutes, Sam

Gore, 55, and Frannie Collin, 70, set them up for victory against Wealdstone, whose only reply came from Greg Ngoyi with 15 minutes to go. Second placed Staines Town's winless run reached nine games as doomed Heybridge Swifts beat them 3–2. Swifts took a two goal lead with a Darti Brown own goal and a 70-yard strike from goalkeeper Ollie Sanders, after 60 and 66 minutes, respectively. Marien Ifura pulled a goal back after 70 minutes, only for Ryan Hull to make it 3–1 with five minutes to go. Leroy Griffiths made it interesting in the last couple of minutes with Staines' second goal. There were four goals in the opening dozen minutes at Harrow Borough, where the home led in the opening 60 seconds, courtesy of Dorian Smith. But Tonbridge Angels hit back through Gavin Dayes, Carl Rook and Paul Booth. Wayne Walters made it 3–2 with 15 minutes left, but Borough could not find an equaliser.

AFC Hornchurch led after half an hour at home to Horsham, courtesy of Simon Parker, and Frankie Curley added two more goals in the second half as the Urchins ran out 3–0 winners. It was even more comprehensive at Princes Park, where already relegated Ramsgate lost 4–0 to Dartford. Rob Haworth scored in each half, while Ryan Hayes and Lee Noble also netted after the interval. Sutton United lost 2–0 at Margate, Joe Healy scoring after 38 minutes and Kenny Pratt after 84. The Gate can still avoid a bottom-four finish, while Sutton need to win their final match of the season – at home to Hornchurch – to reach the playoffs. Carshalton are fifth in the table after Charlie Ide, 14 minutes, Richard Jolly, 65, and a late Junior Kadi penalty was enough to beat Harlow Town 3–1. The Hawks goal came from Chris Ellerbeck, after 62 minutes.

A last minute goal from Dean Palmer was the only one of the game at Short Lane and it gave hosts Ashford Town (Middlesex) all three points against Maidstone United. Dave Wareham gave Billericay Town the lead soon after half-time against Boreham Wood at New Lodge, but Lee Allinson equalised for the Wood ten minutes from the end. Hastings United went 1–0 down at home to Hendon when Glenn Garner scored after 12 minutes. But Rhys Whyborne equalised four minutes later and substitute Matt Maclean scored Us winner 12 minutes from time. Goals from Dean McDonald and Paul Vines either side of half-time set up Tooting & Mitcham United for their 3–1 win over Canvey Island, Leon Gordon pulled a goal back after 72 minutes, but Vines got his second late on.

Division One North

Kris Newby scored twice, one a penalty, in the first half, to give East Thurrock United a cushion at Waltham Forest. Yacine Hamada reduced the arrears after 58 minutes, but Ben Wood and Martin Tuohy sealed the 4–1 win with goals in the last ten minutes. Aveley, however, conceded an early goal at home to Maldon Town, Neil Love netting after 14 minutes. Although Richard Ketchell equalised after 28 minutes, the Millers couldn't snatch a winner and now must win at East Thurrock next week to clinch the title. Brentwood Town are comfortable in third place and Sherwin Stanley and Nicky Simmonds scored in the first half hour at Cheshunt. Although Julian Edwards did make it 2–1 after 36 minutes, Danny Clozier added a third for Brentwood with 15 minutes to go.

There was a superb finish at Witham Town. The Essex club may already be guaranteed a bottom-two finish, but they battled to the very end to snatch a dramatic point at home to Leyton. Phil Kane and Robert Carter scored for Leyton before half-time, but Josh Goody pulled one back soon after the resumption. Carter grabbed his second with eight minutes left, seemingly guaranteeing victory for the visitors. But James Robinson halved the deficit after 85 minutes and, three minutes later, goalkeeper Rhys Madden became the second goalkeeper to score, when he netted the equaliser. Tilbury and Wingate & Finchley both also scored three times in home wins. Michael Begg and Chris Stowe, twice, were on target for the Dockers against Potters Bar Town, whose responses came from Alex Bolt, 37 minutes, and Sam Adejokun, 79. At the Abrahams Stadium, Chris Chase and Dean Williams put Wingate & Finchley in the driving seat against Thamesmead Town. Toby Russell pulled a goal back midway through the second half, but Marvin Samuel made it 3–1 in the last minute.

Four matches ended 1–0. Matt Solly's 73rd-minute penalty was enough for Chatham Town at home to Waltham Abbey. Danny Heale's spot-kick, after 18 minutes, was Concord Rangers' winner at home to Hillingdon Borough. At Chestnut Avenue, Eugene Ofori scored after just five minutes to give Northwood victory at home to Great Wakering Rovers. And at Oakside, visitors Ware took all three points from Redbridge, courtesy of Kai Ramshaw's effort after 28 minutes.

Division One South

Dulwich Hamlet looked like party poopers when Scott Simpson scored after 25 minutes at Kingstonian. But the Ks drew level through Dean Lodge with ten minutes to go and Tommy Williams netted the home team's winner – and championship-clinching goal – three minutes from time. The win eventually didn't matter for Kingstonian, because Cray Wanderers slipped up in spectacular style become the first team to lose a League match to Crowborough Athletic since 9 November. Wayne Clarke scored the only goal ten minutes into the second half. Fleet Town moved to within a point of the Wands as Mark Anderson, 18 minutes, and Steve Hemmings, 61, were on target at home to Folkestone Invicta. At Leylands Park, Metropolitan Police won by the same scoreline against hosts Burgess Hill Town. Scott Forrester, 50 minutes, and a late Steve Sargent penalty were enough for the Blues to take the points.

Worthing's superior goal difference – 14 better than sixth-placed Sittingbourne – probably makes their 2–1 home defeat against Croydon Athletic a non-fatal blow to their playoff hopes. Paul Kennett gave the Rebels the lead after 55 minutes, but Croydon hit back through Ben Godfrey and got an 83rd-minute winner from Shabazz Baidoo. The Brickies, meanwhile, kept up the pressure on the top five with a 3–1 defeat of Whyteleafe at the Bourne Stadium. Hicham Akhazzan scored after 28 minutes, and Mark De Bolla added a second after 70 minutes. The Leafe responded through Ricardo Williams with 16 minutes to go, but Elie Kayembe got Sittingbourne's third four minutes later.

Merstham stay seventh after Kevin Lock and Ross White netted in the second half at home to Corinthian-Casuals, who were briefly level through Gavin Cartwright. Ashford Town also won, 2–0 at Eastbourne Town, with Danny Lye, 33 minutes, and Mitchell Sherwood, 48, the men on target. Whitstable Town took a two-goal half-time lead at Walton Casuals, courtesy of Ian Pulman and Jack Tanner, then held on for victory after Anthony Gale converted a penalty after 73 minutes.

The day's only hat-trick hero was Godalming Town's Glenn Stanley. He netted after 25, 39, and 58 minutes against Chipstead, giving them the lead on three occasions, because the Chips equalised through Kofi Quarty, 36 minutes, and Baptiste Bogle, 48. Brahim Eloumani made it 4–2 with 14 minutes left. At the other end of the scale, there were no goals

at all at Stompond Lane when Leatherhead visited Walton & Hersham.

Ryman Youth League

Staines Town extended their lead at the top of the North West Division with a 3-1 home win on Tuesday evening against Carshalton Athletic, and now lead AFC Wimbledon by eight points with just two games remaining – both against the Young Dons.

On the same evening, Hampton & Richmond Borough shared four goals and the points with visitors Kingstonian. Then on Thursday evening Tooting & Mitcham completed their League programme for the season, losing 2-1 at home to Woking, consolidating their third place in the process.

Third placed Lewes slipped again on Tuesday evening, losing 2-1 at Eastbourne Town, Jacob Jones scoring the two all important goals for the home side in the 25th and 75th minutes. Lewes, having to play some their side in the Club's first team at the moment, look less and less likely to win the Division at the moment. Horsham won their fifth match of the season on the same evening, beating visitors Burgess Hill Town 2-1.

Essex interest in the Isthmian Youth Cup disappeared this week, as both Brentwood Town and Billericay Town both lost at home in midweek. Brentwood Town lost at home by the only goal of an excellent match, losing out to an injury time strike from AFC Wimbledon's Vincent Borges-da-Silva, whilst Billericay lost 0-3 at home to Tonbridge Angels – Oliver Funnell scoring two of the goals.

FA PLAYER RETAIN LISTS

(Repeated from Bulletin No. 33)

All Clubs in the National League System operating at Steps 1 to 4 down to Step 7 registering players under written contracts are required to complete a Retained list for players being retained for the 2009-10 season or subsequent seasons.

Clubs should have received a full information pack from the FA in the last few weeks that included specimen letters and a detailed circular. If any member clubs have not received this information please contact the FA Registrations Department urgently.

FA Rule C.1(j)(xv) requires a Retained List to be forwarded to the FA no later than 1st June each year. This year Clubs failing to conform to the deadline will be charged under the provisions of FA Rules and Regulations.

Forms can also be downloaded from the FA's ICE system.

The relevant FA Rule is C.1(j)(iii) which states: 'Within 7 days of the first Saturday in May, or the date of the last competitive match of the Club's first team, whichever is the later, the Club must give notice in writing to the Player indicating that either the Club offers re-engagement or, if appropriate, exercises any option contained in the agreement.'
