WEEKEND REVIEW

Premier Division

Four Premier Division clubs enjoyed six-point Bank Holiday weekends, and none of them will be happier than Kingstonian. Last season's Division One South champions had lost their first four games and manager Alan Dowson took drastic action, signing seven new players before Saturday's trip to Hendon. But it was one of the old guard, Bobby Traynor, who gave them the lead four minutes before the interval and victory was sealed by injury-time strikes from substitutes Karl Beckford and Simon Huckle.

Ks finished with even more of a flourish at Carshalton on Monday. Richard Jolly's 13th-minute goal looked likely to be unlucky for the

visitors but Carshalton, by then down to ten men, were stunned as Traynor equalised in the 88th minute and then grabbed the winner. It made it a miserable weekend for Carshalton, previously unbeaten. They were whipped 4-0 at Aveley on Saturday thanks to a burst of three goals in 11 minutes midway through the first half. Sherwin Stanley, Junior Dadson and Mitch Hahn were the marksmen. Ryan Doyle added a late penalty.

And Millers followed up by taking a second-minute lead through Matt Johnson at Hendon on Monday. But they had top scorer Martin Tuohy dismissed before the game was 30 minutes old and Hendon made the most of it. Dave Diedhiou soon levelled matters, James Bent put them ahead 12 minutes after the break and late strikes by Danny Dyer and Peter Dean made it 4-1.

Sos Yao, just signed from Hornchurch, scored in each of Boreham Wood's 2-0 wins, their first successes of the season. He netted the second at Ashford (Middx) on Saturday after another ex-Urchin, Dean Green, had given Wood the lead. Then Yao converted a penalty midway through the first half of Monday's home game against Billericay and Greg Morgan made it 2-0 just before the break.

Paul Vines and Aaron Goode were the men responsible for Tooting's holiday double which lifted them to second in the table. They were both on target in Saturday's 2-1 win at Maidstone, who led at half-time through Dan Stubbs. Vines then buried two superb headers to give the Terrors a 2-0 half-time lead against Bognor on Monday. Michael Birmingham's

penalty gave Bognor hope but they had Gary Norgate sent off and Goode made it 3-1.

You had to feel sorry for Bognor, who have had more than their share of troubles in the past year. They were jubilant on Saturday when Charlie Oatway scored their first goal of the season in the 93rd minute to equalise against Waltham Abbey but the celebrations were rudely halted when Harry Elmes responded to give Abbey their first-ever Premier Division victory. His brother James then got the leveller in Monday's 1-1 draw with Harrow.

Five points from three games made it an excellent start for new Waltham Abbey manager Glen Alzapiedi. The former Ware and Harlow boss took charge at Capershots after Tony Tillbrook and coach Andy Purcell left by mutual consent three matches into the season. Alzapiedi watched his new team given the runaround at Billericay last Tuesday only to somehow escape with a 1-1 draw when Billy Holland scored a last-minute equaliser against his former club.

The other six-pointers were Hastings United. Ade Olorunda claimed both goals in a 2-1 win at Cray on Saturday and they shrugged off a second-minute goal by Ben Andrews to beat Horsham 3-1 in Monday's all-Sussex affair. Michael Phillips took only two minutes to level the scores, with Scott Ramsay and Sam Adams clinching victory after the break.

It was a tale of three penalties as Tonbridge climbed to third place in the table. Carl Rook's spot-kick, only five minutes after he came off the bench, wiped out Lawrence Yiga's opener in a 1-1 draw at Billericay and, after visitors Ashford had led 2-1 through Michael Bulley and Paul Johnson, Rook converted twice more from 12 yards to snatch victory on Monday. Other penalty marksmen on Saturday were Canvey's Craig Davidson, to give them a 2-1 win at Horsham, and Harrow's Rocky Baptiste, setting his side on their way to a 3-0 victory over Margate. But Mark Janney, usually deadly from 12 yards for Hornchurch, missed the chance to put his side back in Saturday's game at Sutton when his kick was saved by Kevin Scriven. Anthony Joseph and Stefan Payne had put Sutton 2-0 up in ten minutes and teenager Payne added another in a 4-1 win.

Payne grabbed his sixth of the season to give Sutton the lead with 18 minutes left at

Wealdstone on Monday but Mark E'Beyer levelled and Danny Spendlove's last-minute goal made it 2-1 for Stones. Chris O'Leary had given Stones the lead at leaders Dartford on Saturday. Lee Burns equalised in the second half but a crowd of 1,150 had to settle for that as Darts dropped their first points of the season. They won 2-0 at Hornchurch on Monday, however, Burns adding his eighth of the season to Elliot Bradbrook's opener, and are three points clear at the top.

Division One North

East Thurrock United are the new leaders after Kurt Smith scored a first-minute goal for the second time in nine days to set them on their way to a 2-0 victory at Heybridge on Monday. They had to wait a long time for the clincher, which came in the 88th minute from James Donovan.

Previous leaders Northwood suffered their first defeat of the season. Lewis Tozer found the net with four minutes left for Thamesmead, whose 1-0 win lifted them to fourth place. Lowestoft fell behind to Toran Senghore's third-minute goal at Leyton and, although Ross King soon levelled matters, the Suffolk club could not find the second goal which would have taken them back to the top of the table.

There were first wins of the season for Cheshunt and Tilbury. Chris Meikle got both goals in Cheshunt's 2-0 home victory against Redbridge while Kayan Kalipha, Rickie Hayles and Julio Barnes were on target for the Dockers as they beat Brentwood 3-1. Petrit Elbi replied.

Chris Thomas gave Maldon a 1-0 lead midway through the second half at his former club, Ilford, and Danny Johnson added another four minutes later. Ilford, down to ten men, scored a late consolation through Jamie Pooley.

Stuart Blackburne's goal was enough to give Enfield Town all three points at VCD while Romford fought out a goalless draw with Wingate & Finchley.

Division One South

Cup replays wrecked the Bank Holiday Monday programme in this division, with only four league games surviving.

The remaining action began with a noon kick-off at Chipstead. It was a glorious day for football on the North Downs but the game was scoreless until the 88th minute, when James

Rose struck for visiting Walton Casuals. Chipstead, yet to win a league game, refused to fold and were awarded a penalty in the last minute of added time. Gareth Graham stayed cool to make it 1-1.

A lone goal by Glen Stanley gave Godalming a 1-0 home win over Leatherhead and kept them on top of the table, leading Folkestone on goal difference. Folkestone won by the same margin at Burgess Hill but had to wait until added time for Michael Yianni to break the deadlock.

The pair are five points clear of Ramsgate, who moved up to third place with a 3-0 victory at the previous tenants of that spot, Corinthian-Casuals. Gary Mickelborough scored a goal in each half before Warren Schulz headed the third.

FA Cup

Frankie Sawyer was the first Ryman League player to find the net in this season's FA Cup. His 69th-minute goal earned Metropolitan Police a 1-0 victory at Chertsey Town in a tie played on Friday night.

Another 40 clubs from Division One were in preliminary round action on Saturday, with 18 going through and 11 earning replays. Six of the casualties were beaten in all-Ryman ties.

The pick of the crop saw Croydon Athletic, fourth in Division One South, host the leaders, Godalming Town. Gary Noel gave Athletic a tenth-minute lead with his eighth goal of the season and Danny Waldren added another before half-time to complete a 2-0 victory.

There was a swift reversal of fortunes for Burgess Hill Town. They won 2-1 in the league at Chipstead seven days earlier but two goals by Danny Curd could not prevent the Surrey club gaining revenge with a 3-2 victory at Leylands Park. Two from Kofi Quartey and one from Wayne Grizzle earned Chipstead the rich reward of a home tie against Premier Division leaders Dartford on Saturday week.

Two other players netted twice in all-Isthmian games but finished on the losing side. Bradley Harrison's double could not avert a 3-2 home defeat for Cheshunt against Maldon Town, for whom Nathan Fletcher hit the decider. And Kayan Kalipha's two goals were slim

consolation for Tilbury, beaten 4-2 at Thamesmead Town for whom Rikki Cable doubled up in his first game since rejoining the club.

Worthing enjoyed the biggest win of the day, netting four unanswered goals against Raynes Park Vale. Ben Johnson completed the triumph with two goals in the last seven minutes.

Leatherhead, a club with a notable FA Cup pedigree, had a comfortable 3-0 home victory over Bedfont Green and Lowestoft Town attracted another 600-plus crowd to watch them see off neighbours Great Yarmouth Town by the same margin.

Two more clubs dropped into the first qualifying round in-tray on Sunday, seeing off Sussex County League opposition in a pair of games that yielded 15 goals.

New Ashford Town signing Luke Coleman made his mark, coming off the bench in the 54th minute of their game against Mile Oak and helping himself to a hat-trick to wrap up a 6-1 win.

Horsham YMCA were given a fright by visitors Wick, who trailed 3-0 soon after half-time but pulled it back to 3-2, then 4-3, before Paul Elliott's second of the game in the 89th minute saw YM through.

RE-REGISTRATION OF PLAYERS

The attention of Clubs is drawn to the following new paragraph of League Rule 6.4.3. which has been included in the standardised rules effect from this season:

"In the event of a Player without a written contract changing his status to that of a Contract player with the same Club, another Club in the Competition or with a Club in another Competition his registration as a Player without a written contract will automatically be cancelled and declared void. In order for him to play in the Competition again either for his original Club or for another Club it will be necessary for him to be re-registered as required by this Rule."
