WEEKEND REVIEW

Premier Division

Dartford look on course to match the achievements of Kent rivals Dover Athletic, who last season amassed 104 points and won the Premier Division title with 22 points to spare.

Just eight games into the current campaign, Darts are eight points clear at the top and their tally of 27 goals is ten more than anyone else has managed. Their trip to Carshalton on Saturday was expected to be a testing one but it turned into a 4-0 romp. Lee Burns took his league tally into double figures and his overall total to 11 with the opener after 22 minutes and Jamie Day made it 2-0 at the break. There was no way back for the Robins as Rob Haworth and Jamie Coyle doubled the score.

LEAGUE NEWS

A respectful distance behind Darts, promoted Aveley moved into second place with a 2-1 victory at Tooting, who started the day in the that slot. Millers were grateful to Tooting defender Joe Vines, whose own goal after 33 minutes wiped out Craig Pitterson's opener. Piers Wixon grabbed the winner three minutes later. Hastings moved up to third – just. It was five minutes into added time when Tim Olurunda netted a disputed equaliser in a 1-1 draw with Billericay, who must have thought that Billy Bricknell's 77th minute effort would be worth three points.

The Kingstonian revival continued with a 2-1 victory at Canvey. Matt Gray gave Ks a half-time lead which James Rowe wiped out six minutes after the restart. Then Simon Huckle headed the winner with 11 minutes to go. Bognor remain rooted at the foot of the table and must have feared worse than their eventual 4-0 defeat at Wealdstone when James Gray and Greg Ngoyi scored in the first eight minutes. It was the 60th minute, however, before Ngoyi struck again, with Ryan Ashe adding a late fourth.

Waltham Abbey were denied their fifth draw in eight games by Byron Harrison, who hit the only goal of the game for visiting Ashford (Middx) with 90 minutes on the clock. Sonny Cobbs performed a similar last-gasp service for Sutton at Tonbridge, though here the margin was 2-1. Tonbridge had taken the lead with a deflected shot from Steve Ferguson just before the interval and Sam Gargan levelled matters in the 53rd minute.

The decisive action at Boreham Wood also came in added time, in this case at the end of

the first half. A penalty by James Pinnock was quickly followed by a Kevin Stephens own goal to give Maidstone a 2-0 victory. Wood striker Jamie Richards was the unlucky goalkeeper, having replaced the injured Tony Tucker. Pat Harding scored in each half for Horsham as they cruised to a 3-1 win at Margate. Alex Haddow was their other marksman, with a penalty. Joe Healy's reply came too late to make any difference.

AFC Hornchurch, with only one draw to show for their previous six games, gained a welcome 2-1 victory over visitors Harrow. Harrow keeper Keito Karamoko gifted Urchins the lead on 30 minutes, miskicking the ball straight to new signing Wayne Gray and then pulling him down. Donny Barnard scored from the spot. Gray himself added the second, though he looked well offside, before Dewayne Clarke managed a consolation, also from the spot, deep into added time.

Overall it was another unhappy day for home clubs. Seven of the day's games produced away wins, of which there have now been 40 in the Premier Division this season. Only 25 matches had gone the way of the hosts.

That became 26 on Sunday when Hendon beat Cray Wanderers 2-0. Yacine Hamada made the breakthrough two minutes before half-time and Jamie Busby added the second after 54 minutes. Victory lifted Hendon to seventh place in the table.

Division One North

Redbridge produced the goal scoring feat of the day in the division. Trailing 2-0 after 58 minutes of their game at Harlow, the Motormen were in front by the hour mark. Leon Diaczuk, Charlie Georgiou and Harry Oniha brought about the transformation, though Harlow recovered from the shock and Ola Akinawo made it 3-3. Ashley Robinson and Jason Mason had scored their earlier goals.

Matt Nolan, Lowestoft's recent signing from Telford United, led his new team to the top of the table with two goals in their 3-1 win at Romford. Gary McGee added to Nolan's opener as the Suffolk club went 2-0 up in the first quarter of the match and, after Paul Burnett gave Romford hope in the 70th minute, Nolan's second clinched it.

Previous leaders East Thurrock fell foul of Great Woking striker Neil Richmond, who

scored a goal in each half for a 2-0 victory. Rocks stay second, a point adrift of the new leaders, while Woking climb to third spot, two points further back.

Potters Bar leap to fourth place after seeing off Waltham Forest 3-1. Danny Gabriel replied to Luke Croll's early goal but Ellis Remy quickly restored the home side's lead and Shane Wyllie clinched the points with his seventh of the season.

Ilford returned to winning ways after four successive defeats. Troy Hewitt put them ahead against Ware, who then held out until the 89th minute before Junior Konadu made it 2-0. Ware are now at the foot of the table after Cheshunt lifted themselves to 18th place with a 2-1 victory over Brentwood.

Chris Thomas, newly arrived at Brentwood from Maldon, was soon off the mark for his new club, giving them a 22nd-minute lead, but Graeme Dearle levelled within five minutes and Bradley Harrison hit the decider soon after the break.

Another newcomer, Sam Adejokun, had more luck. Adejokun, just arrived at Heybridge from Waltham Forest, put his new side ahead after 35 minutes and Nick Muir added another five minutes later as high-flying visitors Thamesmead were beaten 2-0.

A single goal on the stroke of half-time by Lyle Taylor earned Concord all three points at Northwood and one was also enough for VCD at home to Maldon, Danny Penny the marksman.

A serious injury to Leyton's Perry Burns brought a premature end to their home game against Enfield Town. Burns suffered a severely-broken ankle in an attempt to block a clearance and, after it had been decided that he could not be moved until an ambulance arrived, the match was abandoned. There had been plenty of action in the previous 62 minutes, with three goals, two of them to the hosts, and a red card apiece.

Division One South

IT WAS a frustrating Saturday afternoon for Leatherhead, who scored two late goals to get on level terms at Chatham only to concede a even later winner. Chatham looked well in command as Lee Barnett and Ray Powell scored early in each half. Marc Elston pulled one back for the visitors but Barnett's second

on 75 minutes restored the two-goal margin. Then Dominic O'Shea gave the Tanners new hope in the 86th minute and Hassan Nyang promptly made it 3-3. Celebrations were premature as Ben Payne struck in the 89th minute to see Chatham home.

Two teams without a win between them influenced affairs at the top end of the table. Chipstead held leaders Folkestone to a goalless draw and could have done better had Jack Delo not saved Gareth Graham's penalty. One point was enough to keep Folkestone on top.

Liam Baitup's last-minute goal for Eastbourne meant that Croydon Athletic forfeited second place. Leon Noel had given Athletic the lead just after half-time to maintain his share of the league's scoring leadership with Dartford's Lee Burns. Both have ten league goals and 11 in all.

The draw could not prevent the Sussex club from dropping to the foot of the table after Ashford beat Whyteleafe 3-2 to record their first win. Sam Butler gave Whyteleafe an interval lead but Ashford hit back through John Guest and Joe Fuller. An exchange of penalties followed, with Mitchell Sherwood making it 3-1 before Butler scored his second. There were still 17 minutes left but Ashford held out to break their duck.

Two of Folkestone's nearest rivals, Godalming and Merstham, clashed at Godalming and it was the hosts who closed the gap at the top to a single point with a comfortable 3-1 victory. It was 2-0 at half-time thanks to Kenny Ojukwu and Liam Pestle, and it was effectively game over when Graeme Purdy added a third just after the restart. Julian Owusu-Bekoe replied for Merstham on the hour but that was their lot.

Eastbourne were not the only club to host a 1-1 draw. Four other games in the division produced the same scoreline and perhaps there's something in the Sussex air, for two of the others were at Burgess Hill and Horsham YMCA. Jason Hollick levelled for the Hillians after Jeff Jackson's opener for Walton Casuals, who had a last-minute penalty saved by Joe Adams, while Steve Metcalf's early strike for YM against Ramsgate was answered by Warren Schulz with a penalty on the hour.

All the significant action at Fleet Town happened in the few minutes either side of the interval. Chris Sharpling gave Met Police the lead in the 42nd minute, somewhat against the

run of play; his side had earlier cleared three Fleet efforts off the line. Five minutes after the break Police defender Craig Wilkins was sent off for a 'professional foul' and Eddie Smith levelled from the spot.

The final 1-1 scoreline was at Corinthian-Casuals, where Glenn Boosey scored for the hosts 15 minutes after the start and Hicham Akhazzan equalised for Sittingbourne 15 minutes from the end. Ross Treleaven and Ben Johnson put Worthing 2-0 up in 24 minutes at Dulwich and that turned out to be the final score. It was also 2-0, though for the home side, at Walton & Hersham. Visiting Whitstable were on course for a draw until Jon Boswell broke the deadlock with 17 minutes to go and David Tarpey quickly added the clincher.

Ryman Youth League

In the Ryman Youth League, the Central Division is already looking highly competitive. After two matches no-one has maximum points and no-one has lost twice. Kingstonian top the table but will feel they should have six points after leading 2-0 against Croydon Athletic only to be held to a 2-2 draw. Sutton United trail them on goal difference after coming from behind to edge out Tooting 2-1.

Carshalton Athletic also came from behind to win the highest-scoring league game of the week, 5-3 at Chipstead. Alex Dawson netted twice for the winners and Ashley Robinson did the same for Chipstead. The other match in the division finished all square thanks to Chris Webster's 75th minute goal for Whyteleafe at Corinthian-Casuals, making it 2-2.

Maidstone top the East Division with six points and an 11-0 goal record. Nathan Faulkes enjoyed himself in Thursday's 7-0 win over Welling, netting four times. Jean-Francois Gnapi and Charlie Swann gave Cray a 2-0 victory at Bromley and the other match in the division, between Tonbridge and Thamesmead, finished scoreless.

Lewes lead the way in the south with Louis Pople nabbing the decider in a 2-1 win over Eastbourne Town. Worthing also found goals harder to come by than on Sunday. They had to wait until the 87th minute but then Alessandro Giammattei and David Herbert struck in quick succession to earn a 2-2 draw with Leatherhead, for whom Dan Tansill and

Jeremy Osei-Bonsu had provided a 2-0 half-time lead.

The week's second 7-0 win came in the West Division, with Hampton on the receiving end at Ashford (Middx). Mark Bitmead added another hat-trick to the one he scored in the FA Youth Cup a week earlier and now has eight in three games.

Ashford lead the way from two other clubs with unblemished records. Woking notched their second success with five unanswered goals at Harrow, including two apiece from Chris Aldridge and Anson Cousins. Staines Town have won both their games by the odd goal with Callum Chickah playing a major role. He scored the fourth in a opening 4-3 win at Hampton and it was the same this week at AFC Wimbledon, where his 88th minute strike opened up a two-goal gap and meant that Callum Wellburn's 90th minute effort for Dons was no more than consolation. Hayes & Yeading had the better of the other game in this division, beating Walton & Hersham 5-2. Jake Flatman scored twice in a minute for Walton to make it 2-2 but Hayes took charge again and Danny Wishart's goal right on half-time put them ahead to stay.
