#### WEEKEND REVIEW

##### FA Cup

Troy Hewitt was the hat-trick hero as Premier Division side Harrow Borough stormed into the first round of the FA Cup with a stunning 4-2 victory at Conference Premier club Eastbourne Borough on Saturday. And they were richly rewarded when Sunday's draw provided them

with a plum home tie against League Two pacesetters Chesterfield.

FA Cup icon Rocky Baptiste also played a major part, heading the opening goal in the fifth minute. Baptiste has featured in fourth-round ties at Highbury and Anfield, for Farnborough and Havant respectively - though he is still best known for the open-goal miss against Waltham Abbey last season which became a massive internet hit!

Luke Rooney hit a post for Eastbourne after Baptiste's strike but Harrow had the upper hand and Hewitt headed against a post before doubling the lead with a shot from the edge of the box in the 20th minute. He added another nine minutes later and completed his treble four minutes after the interval. Jamie Taylor gave Eastbourne a glimmer of hope a minute later but it was the 88th minute before Andy Atkin got their second.

It is only the third time Harrow have reached the first round. Ten years ago they were beaten 3-0 at Wycombe and in 1983 they pulled off a 1-0 win on the famous Yeovil slope before going down 3-1 at home to Newport County, then a strong Division Three side, in the second round.

Carshalton were cruelly denied their place in the first round by a 95th-minute Chelmsford equaliser at Colston Avenue and will have to try again in Essex tomorrow (Monday).

The Robins thought they were through when substitute Anthony Joseph gave them a 1-0 lead with 89 minutes on the clock, only for Rob Edmonds to head the equaliser deep into added time.

Earlier, the bar twice denied Byron Harrison his eighth FA Cup goal of the season while, for Chelmsford, last season's Ryman golden boot winner Sam Higgins twice went close.

Carshalton win the replay there will be an all-Ryman tie in the first round, for they or Chelmsford will host one of the league's other two survivors. Hendon and Metropolitan Police battled out a 0-0 draw at Wembley on Saturday and will meet again at Imber Court on Wednesday.

Hendon should have got the better of the only Division One side left in the competition, who were reduced to ten men when Ron Edwards was dismissed in the second half. Craig Vargas and Casey Maclaren both hit the Police bar before the interval and visiting keeper Mo Maan was outstanding.

### **Premier Division**

Kingstonian marched to the top of the Premier Division as a Dean Lodge double led them to a 4-0 victory at Croydon Athletic on Saturday.

Lodge opened the scoring after 17 minutes but Croydon were unlucky not to reply, with Reggie Savage and Rob George both hitting the woodwork. Two goals in two minutes midway through the second half, from Bobby Traynor and Lodge, settled the outcome and Carl Wilson-Dennis added a fourth.

The result took K's to the top because both Lowestoft and Sutton were held to draws. It was a day to forget for Lowestoft, who hit traffic trouble on the way to Hastings and did not arrive until the scheduled kick-off time. Then, when play got under way at 3.30, the Trawlerboys held out for a 0-0 draw but finished with nine men after Lee McGlone and Andy Fisk saw red.

Karl Murray was the main man at Sutton. He handled to allow Ross Lover to give visiting Cray a 1-0 lead from the spot after five minutes, then scored the equaliser with a deflected shot on the half-hour.

Claude Seanla fired a hat-trick in the last seven minutes of the first half as Tonbridge won 3-0 at Aveley to move up to fifth. Millers must be sick of Seanla, whose goal for Boreham Wood beat them in last season's play-off semi-final.

Injury-hit Bury suffered only their second league defeat of the season, going down 3-1 at home to Hornchurch. The usually free-scoring Martin Tuohy, who has started the season slowly, doubled his total with a goal in each half before Rickie Hayles headed home to make it 3-0 after 68 minutes. A flicked header by Craig Nurse gave Bury late consolation.

There were also three goals for Concord, who beat visiting Tooting 3-0. The bar denied Harry Elmes the opener for the home side but helped in Nicky Cowley's header in the 37<sup>th</sup> minute. Tony Stokes added a 64<sup>th</sup> minute penalty and Jacob Erskine hit the third.

Maidstone edged off the bottom, above Horsham who were without a game, with a 1-1 draw at fellow-strugglers Wealdstone. Adrian Stone's penalty miss just before half-time looked as if it would be costly for the Kent club when Greg Ngoyi put the home Stones ahead in the 73<sup>rd</sup> minute. The visiting Stones got another penalty with four minutes left, however, and this time Colin Richmond made no mistake.

Billericay and Margate battled out an uninspiring 0-0 draw at New Lodge. The visitors held out with ten men for the last 20 minutes after Jay Saunders was sent off.

### **Division One North**

Redbridge broke their Division One North duck in style on Saturday. The Motormen, with just two draws and five goals to show for their first ten games, romped to a 4-0 home victory over Brentwood to climb off the foot of the table.

Having come within six minutes of that elusive win at Grays on Wednesday, Redbridge were not to be denied this time. Ellis Skidmore set them on their way with two goals in six minutes just before half-time. Kevin McLeod and Hyun-Jin Lee doubled the total.

There were also two goals for Redbridge's top scorer Alex Read and if you think Saturday's four goals have already been accounted for, you're right. Read joined Romford this week and netted twice in eight second-half minutes as they won 2-0 at Ware. Ryan Wade, back at Ware from Cambridge City, hit the bar twice before Read opened the scoring.

The new leaders are Harlow, who had Clark Akers to thank for the 79<sup>th</sup> minute goal which

gave them a hard-fought 1-0 home win over AFC Sudbury.

Previous table-toppers Enfield Town suffered a shock 3-0 home defeat by lowly Great Wakering. The damage was done in a two-minute spell just before the half-hour which brought goals for Luca Frankis and Ty Benjamin. Billy Johnson added a third 12 minutes into the second half, while the best Enfield could manage were two efforts that were cleared off the line as they dropped to fourth place.

Needham Market are up to second place, with at least two games in hand on all the other top sides, after a 3-2 home win over Cheshunt. They made hard work of it after Sam Newson's first-minute strike. It was the 73<sup>rd</sup> minute before he made it 2-0 with his 12<sup>th</sup> of the season. Chris Meikle pulled one back, James Evans netted Needham's third and although Josh Hutchinson closed the gap again it was by then deep into added time.

Heybridge, in third place, were held to a 1-1 home draw by Waltham Forest, whose unkind reward was to slip to the foot of the table and become the only side in the league with a victory. Tom Broadhurst's header gave Swifts the lead soon after half-time but Forest fought back and new signing Mitch Hahn hit the bar with a free-kick before Marquin Smith fired the equaliser with 20 minutes left.

Thamesmead, who are fifth, were also held to a 1-1 home draw by lowly opposition, Leyton, in a game of three penalties. Leyton's Sol Patterson-Bohner missed the first of them but Gabriel Momodu made no mistake for the home side, nor did Taurean Roberts when he equalised in the 84<sup>th</sup> minute after an offence for which Lew Tozer was sent off.

Wingate are right on Thamesmead's heels after coming from behind to win 3-1 at Ilford. Liam Thomas put Ilford ahead six minutes before half-time but Leon Smith turned it round with a double in the first 13 minutes of the second half. He scored four times on his last visit to the ground, a 4-3 win over Waltham Forest in March, but this time he settled for two as Josh Cooper wrapped it up.

Draw specialists Waltham Abbey were at it again, letting a two-goal lead slip and sharing the points for the seventh time in 12 games as Max Cornhill grabbed a last-gasp leveller for visiting East Thurrock. A Louis Bristow free-

kick had given Abbey an 18<sup>th</sup> minute lead which Kieran Ogunkoya quickly doubled, only for Neil Richmond to pull one back in the 28<sup>th</sup> minute.

Maldon won 2-0 at Tilbury with a goal shortly before half-time from Dean Fenton and one immediately after it by Lee Blackburn.

Potters Bar also claimed three points on the road. Elvis Balic gave them a 24<sup>th</sup> minute lead at Grays which Denis Paratusic doubled around the hour mark. Alex Osborn made it 2-1 with nine minutes left and that was how it finished.

### **Division One South**

It was an action-packed Saturday afternoon in Division One South, where ten games yielded 40 goals. Three of them were scored by Corinthian-Casuals, who chalked up their first success of the season with a 3-1 home victory over Horsham YMCA in the battle of the bottom two.

It was the visitors who went ahead in only the second minute through Antoine Douglas. Matt Powell replied in the 17<sup>th</sup> minute and Midi Nsubuga put Casuals ahead on the stroke of half-time. They made sure of victory when Powell scored again with 20 minutes left, though they remain a point behind their victims at the foot of the table.

Top scorers were Bognor, who fired six unanswered goals at Godalming. Jason Prior led the way with a hat-trick by the 50<sup>th</sup> minute, taking his haul for the season to 11. Kane Wills also scored in the first half. An own goal by home keeper Paul McCarthy made it five and James Fraser hit the sixth. There were still 22 minutes left but the G's were spared further punishment apart from a late red card for Josh Coke.

Ramsgate were also among the goals, beating Walton Casuals 5-1 in Kent. Mark Lovell opened their account with a 12<sup>th</sup>-minute penalty and Tom Tsangarides added his first two goals of the season in the next 12 minutes. Casuals had Liam Hind sent off five minutes before half-time but still pulled a goal back through Luke Evans, only for a second Lovell penalty to make it 4-1 at the break. Mitch Sherwood completed the haul with seven minutes left.

There were six goals at Chipstead, too, four of them by visiting Fleet. They made light of the

absence of 17-goal Johnnie Dyer, who was suspended, taking a sixth-minute lead through Darren Campbell and adding two more by half-time, an own goal by Adam Broomhead and a Dan Read shot. They were shaken out of their comfort zone by two goals in as many minutes midway through the second half, Ray Freeman and Craig Gardner the marksmen. But Fleet held on and Darren Wheeler wrapped it up with a penalty in added time after he was brought down by keeper Martin Grant, who was sent off.

Eastbourne also scored four times, one each for their four leading scorers, though it was visitors Faversham who went ahead with a ninth-minute strike by Danny Lye. Sam Crabb equalised moments before half-time and the second half belonged to the hosts as Brad Manton, Ashley Robinson – his tenth of the season - and Evan Archibald all found the net.

Leaders Leatherhead were held to a 1-1 draw at Chatham, who took the lead in the 61<sup>st</sup> minute through Leory Huggins. Greg Andrews replied with a penalty 11 minutes later, his 13<sup>th</sup> league goal of the season. No other marksman has yet reached double figures in league matches alone. The Tanners now lead Met Police by six points but the boys in blue still have their 100 per cent record and five games in hand.

A post denied Whitehawk a probable win at Sittingbourne, where it finished 2-2. Jamahl Hughes opened the scoring for Hawks shortly before the interval and Paul Semakula levelled shortly after it. Joe Gatting headed home to restore Hawks' lead on 62 minutes but the woodwork foiled Ben Godfrey's attempt to make it 3-1 and the hosts grabbed a point through Tom Bradbrook in the 88<sup>th</sup> minute.

There was late action at Whitstable. Ian Pulman gave the hosts an 80<sup>th</sup> minute lead against Burgess Hill, who made it 1-1 through Will Berry with two minutes left.

Merstham's Wes Goggin struck after 78 minutes at Dulwich and that was enough to give the visitors a 1-0 victory.

Chris O'Flaherty scored early in each half to set up Whyteleafe's 3-1 win at Walton & Hersham. Bentley Graham made it 3-0 on 71 minutes and, although Dwane Lee pulled one back with a penalty shortly afterwards, it was slim consolation for the Swans who finished

with nine men thanks to injuries and a red card for Liam Collins.

## Ryman Youth League

A late goal by Oliver Hinkley fired Carshalton Athletic into the first round proper of the FA Youth Cup on Wednesday and set an example for the club's senior side, who were aiming to do the same in the FA Cup three days later. A hat-trick by Sonny Ayres gave the young Robins a 3-0 lead inside 32 minutes against Chesham, who fought back to level the scores by midway through the second half. Hinkley struck the decisive blow after 87 minutes and Carshalton will now visit Rushden & Diamonds.

Two more Ryman Youth League sides went through. George Frith scored twice as Woking beat Leatherhead 4-0 to earn themselves a trip to Colchester and a Lamin Cole double led Northwood to a 3-0 victory at Camberley; they now host Dulwich.

There was plenty of action in the league itself during the week, which was especially productive for Whitehawk. A Kieran Pamment strike gave them a 1-0 victory at Burgess Hill on Monday and they followed up three days later with a 4-0 home win over Horsham YMCA which took them to the top of the South-East division.

Maidstone are three points behind them with two games in hand after enjoying their own 4-0 home win on Thursday. All the goals came in the last 15 minutes, including two from Jack Simon, as they saw off Kent rivals Ashford. At the other end of the table, Worthing remain without a point after a 2-1 home defeat by Horsham. Marcus Collier netted the clincher.

Whyteleafe snatched a 2-1 home victory over Kingstonian in the Central section with a last-minute goal by Peter Sherlock. It was Kingstonian's first defeat, in their eighth game, but they remain seven points clear at the top of the table with Leafe now second.

A George Griffiths hat-trick lifted Walton & Hersham into third place with a 3-1 win over Chipstead while Leyton broke their duck in style after five straight defeats, hitting five unanswered goals against Metropolitan Police.

The joint leaders in the West division, Hayes & Yeading and Staines, fought out a thrilling 3-3

draw. Mario Quiassaca's second of the game put Staines 3-2 up with ten minutes left only for George Isaac to hit his own second less than a minute later.

Ashford (Middx) were the week's highest scorers, beating Barnet Black 6-0. Perry Luckins netted twice, as did Hampton's Daniel Thompson in their 4-0 victory over Fleet.
