### LEAGUE NEWS

#### Macron Manager of the Month

Some Tonbridge fans were calling for Tommy Warrilow's head after a 4-0 home defeat by Cray on September 21. The club responded by extending his contract, October began with a 7-1 win over Hornchurch and the Angels have rocketed up the table, taking 13 points from five games during the month.

Great Waking's progress has been almost identical. They were 18<sup>th</sup> at the start of October but won all four league games in the month and are now in the top half of the table.

Fleet also started the season slowly but took maximum points from their three October matches.

#### Macron Team Performance of the Month

This award recognises a particularly noteworthy performance by a Club during the month in any first-team competition. October usually sees many strong team efforts, and this year was no different, with many clubs putting in performances that warranted consideration.

Harrow Borough lifted the Macron award for the Premier Division with their 4-2 FA Cup victory at Conference National side Eastbourne Borough on Saturday, 23<sup>rd</sup> October. They stunned their rivals from two Leagues higher, moving four goals clear by just four minutes after half-time with Troy Hewitt contributing a hat-trick to a strong and superb team performance. Although the Conference club



clawed two goals back, Harrow advanced to the First Round Proper of the FA Cup with a 4-2 win.

AFC Sudbury were the Macron award winners for Division One North as they set aside a somewhat disappointing start to the season, by their own standards, to knock two Premier Division sides out of the FA Trophy. In the middle of the month they won 2-1 at Canvey Island, only to improve on that performance on the last weekend of the month with a stunning 5-1 home win against Hendon.

Whitehawk received the September Macron award for Division One South for a 6-0 win.

But October winners Leatherhead went five goals better: in a true team performance, table-topping Tanners beat Horsham YMCA 11-0 on 9<sup>th</sup> October, with nine of the team on the goalscoring list. And it was away from home.

### **Sells Goalkeeping Academy Good Hands**

This prize is, very simply, awarded to the goalkeeper in each division whose team have had the best defensive record during the month.

Lowestoft conceded one goal in five games, Harlow kept a clean sheet throughout October, when they played three times, and Leatherhead let in two goals in their three matches.

## **WEEKEND REVIEW**

### **Premier Division**

It was Canvey's day in the Premier Division on Saturday. Only two matches took place because of the FA Trophy, and the island's clubs won both of them away from home.

Concord, in their first season at this level, moved up to fourth place with their 2-0 victory at FA Cup heroes Harrow. Nicky Cowley headed them into the lead after 12 minutes and Lee White added the second with a long-range free-kick 20 minutes after half-time.

Canvey Island themselves won 3-1 at Aveley after a flying start which saw them 2-0 up after 11 minutes. A fumble by home keeper Dave McCarthy allowed Danny Heale to open the scoring and John Easterford made no mistake with a free header to double the lead.

Aveley raised their game after the break and Josh Llewellyn, a new signing from Bishop's

Stortford, headed home after 52 minutes to give them a chance of some reward. But Canvey held out and made sure with a late penalty from Rob King after a foul by substitute Spencer Harrison, who received his second yellow card for the offence.

At first glance Canvey, in 14<sup>th</sup> place, are very much second-best on the island but a closer look shows that they are four points behind their neighbours with two games in hand.

### **Division One North**

It could hardly be much tighter at the top of Division One North, where three points cover the first ten clubs after Saturday's games.

Now at the head of affairs are Needham Market, who have also played fewer games than anyone else in the division. They took over the leadership with a 3-1 victory at bottom club Waltham Forest. Nathan Stone put them ahead after 19 minutes, becoming the third Marketman to reach double figures for the season, and Sam Newson added his 13<sup>th</sup> of the campaign two minutes later. Brian Okwera pulled one back in the 65<sup>th</sup> minute only for Stone to restore the two-goal gap shortly afterwards.

Previous leaders Harlow, who were in Trophy action, dropped to second and Wingate joined the top two on the 24-point mark with a 4-1 home win over Leyton. Gary Burrell converted a penalty in each half, with Enoch Akosah being sent off for the second offence. Lewis Jones made it 3-0 but Leyton deservedly pulled one back through Stefan Cox before Chris Chase wrapped it up.

Among the other teams in that tight top ten, East Thurrock, Maldon and Potters Bar all enjoyed 2-1 home victories.

Maldon, having taken the lead on the half-hour through Paul Shave, thought they would have to settle for a point when Liam Farrell grabbed a last-minute equaliser for Waltham Abbey. But there was still time for Joe Sweeney to win it with his 11<sup>th</sup> of the season.

Kris Newby scored his tenth from the penalty spot in the 36<sup>th</sup> minute to equalise for East Thurrock and Kye Ruel scored what proved to be the winner a minute after the break. Unlucky visitors Ilford had taken a fifth-minute lead through Sam Adejokun, who almost saved a point with a shot that hit the bar.

Potters Bar went 2-0 up in the first half hour through Tom Pett and Elvis Balic against Heybridge, who needed a win to take over at the top. But they could only reply with a Tom English penalty and are in fifth place.

Improving Great Wakering moved into the top half of the table with a 3-2 win over Ware, with Dan Trenkel setting up all three goals. John Bradley opened their account in the 12<sup>th</sup> minute and, after Matt Mitchell's penalty leveller on 43 minutes, Bradley Walsh restored the lead before the interval. Ashley Hawkins added a third and Mitchell's 87<sup>th</sup> minute free-kick was not enough to save the visitors.

A goal in each half, by Dee Okojie and Joel Barnett, earned Brentwood a 2-0 win at Tilbury in the day's other game.

### **Division One South**

Chatham Town ended Metropolitan Police's 100 per cent record with a 2-2 draw at Imber Court on Saturday. Few would have given much for their chances after Craig Brown and Eddie Smith gave the home side a 2-0 lead in the first half-hour, especially as the boys in blue had conceded only two league goals all season.

But Ray Powell's penalty deep into added time at the end of the first half gave Chats some hope and they equalised with a Brad Potter header on the hour. That stirred the Police into life but Chats keeper James Tedder atoned for presenting them with their second goal by pulling off several outstanding saves.

So Leatherhead, who had no game, still lead the table by five points, though the Met have four matches in hand. Bognor, in third place, were on FA Trophy duty but stayed put as the two teams a point behind them were both beaten.

Sittingbourne went down to a 24<sup>th</sup> minute goal by Darren Wheeler at Fleet while Burgess Hill lost 3-2 at home to Walton & Hersham in an eventful affair.

Nick Fogden headed the Hillians in front after four minutes but by the 26<sup>th</sup> minute he found himself between the posts to face a penalty after keeper Joel Harding was sent off for bringing down Phil Williams. Dean Thomas made no mistake with the spot-kick and defender Richard Taylor put the visitors ahead

two minutes later. Kenny Ojukwu made it 3-1 in the hour but Steve Harper pulled one back three minutes with a penalty for a push by Adam Howarth, who was himself sent off shortly afterwards.

The red card was also given a thorough airing at Faversham, who drew 2-2 with Chipstead. Anthony-James Morrison put the visitors in front after 21 minutes, Alex Waugh replied and Chipstead went ahead again before half-time through Craig Gardner. Tom Hickman made it 2-2 midway through the second half, shortly after Faversham manager Justin Luchford had been dismissed from the bench. His brother, Dane, was then sent off along with Chipstead's Adam Broomhead and Billy Chattaway following a brawl.

Eastbourne hoped to follow up their impressive midweek win at Bognor with success in another Sussex derby, at Horsham YMCA. Although Antoine Douglas gave YM an early lead, Eastbourne looked on course as Brett Patton equalised and Sam Crabb put them ahead on the stroke of half-time. But lowly YM launched a late rally and took the points with two goals in the last 13 minutes from Spencer Sachies and Gavin Gordon.

The scoreline was the same at Whyteleafe where Josh Smith gave the home side a third-minute lead and they made it 3-0 by half-time through Freddie Fleming and a Steven Lloyd own goal. Stuart Vahid pulled one back on 73 minutes and Ian Pulman reduced the arrears further, but too late.

An own goal by Tony Timms gave Merstham a half-time lead at home to Worthing, who equalised early in the second half with a volley by Tom Lawley. Harry Ottaway restored Merstham's advantage but, with time beginning to run out, Terry Dodd and Michael Hockett each netted their tenth goals of the season to put Rebels in front, only for a last-ditch strike by Jordan Cheadle to make it 3-3.

There were six goals, too, at Whitehawk, where the hosts overcame Ramsgate 4-2 with goals from substitutes Ben Godfrey and Jamie Brotherton in the last 16 minutes. Mark Lovell opened the scoring for Rams after four minutes but they were behind by the 19-minute mark as Josh Jones and Jamahl Hughes swooped for Hawks. James Gregory's long-range strike made it 2-2 at half-time and it stayed that way until Godfrey claimed his tenth

goal of the season, including two for Croydon Athletic, in the 74<sup>th</sup> minute. The chance was supplied by Hughes, who also set up Brotherton's late clincher.

A 57<sup>th</sup> minute penalty by Mark Nicholls gave Walton Casuals a 2-1 win over Corinthian-Casuals. Danny Buckle's early header for Walton was wiped out by Matt Powell just after half-time. Then a foul on Alfie Arthur gave Nicholls his chance.

## FA Trophy

Division One North side Sudbury produced Saturday's star performance in the FA Trophy, thrashing Premier Division high-fliers and FA Cup survivors Hendon 5-1 in Suffolk.

Hendon actually scored first through Lubo Guentchev in the 16<sup>th</sup> minute. Rhys Darg headed the equaliser 11 minutes later and Dave Wareham struck a crucial blow when he gave Sudbury the lead just before half-time. The hosts dominated the second half and James Baker made it 3-1 in the 66<sup>th</sup> minute, after which Darg and Daniel Emmanuel completed an impressive display.

Harlow lost the Division One North leadership during the afternoon but had ample compensation by beating Premier Division Carshalton 2-0 at Burrows Farm. The damage was done early; Che Stadhart opened the scoring after 17 minutes and Clark Akers added the second six minutes later.

Only one other Division One club went through, also from the north. That was Romford, who came from behind to win 3-1 at Zamaretto Division One promotion-chasers Totton. Trailing to a Stefan Brown goal at half-time, Boro drew level two minutes after the restart through Richard Oxby. Danny Rafis dived to head home into the lead after 69 minutes and Joe Pearman clinched it with six minutes left, making it a happy journey home from Southampton.

A fourth One North club in Monday's draw are Thamesmead, who battled out a 0-0 draw at Premier Division Folkestone and will try again on Tuesday. Folkestone's Frankie Chappell hit the bar, Thamesmead's Kai Bichard struck a post.

Only one side from the northern division were beaten on Saturday; Enfield Town lost 2-0 at in-form Premier outfit Tonbridge. Sonny Miles

made the breakthrough on the half-hour and Danny Walder's deflected free-kick doubled the lead moments before the interval.

Two Division One South clubs will be in the hat for the third qualifying round, but only one will play in it. Bognor or Godalming must replay on Tuesday after netting a goal apiece in Sussex. Richard Shittu gave the G's a 16<sup>th</sup>-minute lead and Luke Nightingale replied ten minutes before the break.

Romford were not the only Ryman League club who faced a long journey to meet Zamaretto opposition. Horsham had the longest of all, a round trip of around 600 miles to Truro. Mark Knee's dismissal for a 'professional foul' two minutes before the end of a goalless first half was the turning point and the Cornish club made the most of their extra man to win 2-0. Andy Watkins and Arran Pugh were the scorers, though Horsham put up a brave fight and Ben Andrews was twice denied by excellent saves.

Dulwich had to travel to north Devon and went down to a lone goal scored by Bideford's Jamie Mudge two minutes after the break. Nyren Clunis was inches away from forcing a replay when he headed against a post.

Sutton's lengthy trip to Evesham ended with success thanks to a deflected shot by Bradley Woods-Garness in the 70<sup>th</sup> minute.

Lowestoft visited Chippenham, who will have to make the reverse journey to the Suffolk coast on Tuesday after a 1-1 draw. An own goal by Greg Tindle put the Trawlerboys ahead after 54 minutes and Alan Griffin replied from the spot with 18 minutes left.

There were two other Ryman-Zamaretto clashes on Saturday and honours were even. A penalty by Bertie Brayley just after the interval gave Billericay the lead at home to Banbury and Anthony Robinson added an insurance goal after 85 minutes; it was needed, because Nabil Sharif replied with a late penalty.

Two clubs who swapped leagues during the summer met at Short Lane and it was Ashford (Miiddx), now of the Zamaretto League, who came out on top with a 2-1 win over Bury Town. The Ryman side took a 32<sup>nd</sup> minute lead with a Chris Henderson penalty but Isaiah Rankin equalised five minutes later and Luke

Hickie hit the winner midway through the second half.

Two all-Ryman Premier ties were settled at the death, most dramatically at Bromley where Cray saw victory snatched from their grasp by Maidstone. Mark Willy's 53<sup>rd</sup> minute header gave Cray the edge and it looked enough even after Rhys Coleman was sent off in the closing stages. But in-form Danny Hockton headed a 90<sup>th</sup> minute equaliser and Cray were left stunned when another header from Tommy Whitnell in added time saw Stones through.

Martin Tuohy gave AFC Hornchurch a fifth-minute lead at Margate and Curtis Robinson squared it with a 64<sup>th</sup> minute header. With a replay looking certain, Elliot Styles nodded home in the 90<sup>th</sup> minute to give Urchins their third away win in eight days.

Three more Ryman League teams were in action on Sunday and they had between them lifted the FA Trophy five times. Kingstonian, winners in 1999 and 2000, hosted 1985 Wembley heroes Wealdstone, who had beaten them 2-1 in the league on Monday.

That was the score on Sunday as well – after five minutes! Peter Dean got a first-minute opener for Wealdstone and K's replied through Matt Gray only to fall behind again seconds later when Greg Ngoyi netted the first goal of his hat-trick. Bobby Traynor made it 2-2 with a penalty midway through the half, Ngoyi got his second – and his tenth of the season - five minutes later and K's levelled for the third time through Max Hustwick in the 33<sup>rd</sup> minute. It was Ngoyi again on 54 minutes and this time K's had no answer. Danny Spendlove struck in the 70<sup>th</sup> minute to complete a 5-3 Stones victory.

Grays, who won the final in 2005 and 2006, came from behind to beat Zamaretto League side Cinderford 2-1 at Rookery Hill and complete an outstanding weekend for Division One North clubs. Lee O'Connor put the men from the Forest of Dean ahead early in the second half. Alex Osborn levelled matters on the hour and a Simon Thomas penalty settled it in the 84<sup>th</sup> minute.

### **Ryman Youth League**

A few Saturdays ago Horsham's two Ryman League clubs conceded 17 goals between them. Their junior sides came close to suffering the same fate in the Ryman Youth

League on Thursday, when they were beaten by a combined score of 15-0.

Brett Caiger hit a hat-trick in 13 first-half minutes as Eastbourne Town beat Horsham 7-0 in the South-East division while three goals from Jack Simon and a Paul Mancktelow double led Maidstone to a 8-0 victory over Horsham YMCA, a result which took them to the top of the table.

Eastbourne's goal spree helped to make up for their 2-0 home defeat by Worthing earlier in the week. Oliver Setchell and Nathan Webster scored as the young Rebels collected their first points of the season.

A sixth-minute goal by Harry Bowles set Lewes on their way to a 4-0 home win over Burgess Hill and a lone strike by Ryan Waterman gave Tonbridge the points at Ashford.

The Central division also produced plenty of goals – at least five in each of the four games. Matt Robinson netted twice as leaders Kingstonian beat Walton & Hersham 4-1 and they now have 20 points – amazingly, twice as many as anyone else, though they have played several more games than their nearest rivals.

Carshalton romped to their first victory of the league season, beating Metropolitan Police 5-1 with the help of a Louis Chin hat-trick.

Chipstead came from a goal down to lead Leatherhead 3-1 at half-time and held on to win 3-2. It was the same scoreline at Thamesmead, though here the hosts were 3-0 up, including an Arlie Desanges double, before Leyton pulled two back.

Goals were more elusive in the West section, where leaders Hayes & Yeading beat Ashford (Middx) 2-0 to increase their lead slightly over Staines, whose 2-1 win over Woking keeps them level on points with Hayes, with a game in hand, but two behind on goal difference.

Barnet Black beat Harrow 1-0 while Hampton and Northwood drew 1-1, Romaine Walker equalising for Northwood in the 88<sup>th</sup> minute.

### **TILBURY FOOTBALL CLUB**

Tilbury Football Club played an ineligible player, Glen Kendall, in the Championship Manager Cup Second Round match against Romford on 13<sup>th</sup> October, 2010, when he had

already played in the competition for Grays Athletic on 15<sup>th</sup> September 2010 against Waltham Forest F.C.

The Club have confirmed that they will not appeal the decision.

The Club reported the misdemeanour immediately to the League, and were subsequently charged with a breach of Cup Rules. The Club have been fined and removed from the Competition, with Romford re-instated.

Romford will now play Aveley at home in the Third Round of the Championship Manager Cup on Tuesday, 16th November, 2010.
