WEEKEND REVIEW

Premier Division

Two early goals by Dale Cockrill set up Lowestoft's 2-1 win at Hornchurch on Saturday and they moved up to fifth place, evicting their hosts from a play-off spot. Urchins were unbeaten in the league since October 2 and Lowestoft had not conceded a league goal since October 5, so a 0-0 draw looked a likely outcome – but not for long.

Martin Tuohy had already missed a good chance for the home side when Cockrill tapped in his first league goal of the season with exactly a minute on the clock. He enjoyed the feeling so much that he did it again in the seventh minute, picking up a weak clearance and firing home from 20 yards via the fingertips of keeper Darren Behcet and a post.

Tuohy hit the inside of a post as Urchins tried to hit back and they eventually breached the Trawlerboys defence nine minutes into the second half with a Rickie Hayles header.

That was to be all, and the game finished on a sour note when, 20 seconds from the end of ten minutes added time, Lowestoft's Scott Mitchell was sent off for a bad tackle and Hornchurch substitute Joe Benjamin followed him for his contribution to the melee that followed.

The Suffolk side are seven points behind leaders Sutton with four games in hand after Paul Doswell's men slumped to a 3-1 defeat at the revived Horsham. Mired in the bottom two for much of the season, Hornets are now in a

comfortable midtable berth after chalking up four successive wins and seven matches unbeaten.

They tore into the tabletoppers on Saturday, going 2-0 up in 11 minutes through former Sutton man Billy Dunn and Jamie Cade, recently signed from Hastings. Sutton gave themselves some hope when Craig Dundas halved the deficit on 57 minutes, only for Pat Harding to restore the gap within two minutes. It could have been four, but Anthony Storey missed a late penalty.

Second-placed Bury were also beaten, though in their case the damage was done late in the game. Sam Ives put them ahead in the 55th minute but visiting Tonbridge equalised with a Jay May header in the 78th minute and Rory Hill's solo effort won it for the Angels deep into added time.

Cray's game at Carshalton was rained off, which meant that Kingstonian were the only team in the top five to collect any points. The much-travelled Allan Tait scored the only goal of their game at Billericay midway through the first half and he has now scored one league goal apiece for Horsham, Folkestone and K's this season. But his debut ended unhappily as he was stretchered off.

Alongside Horsham, the in-form side are Harrow and they reached new heights with a thumping 6-1 home win over Canvey. It was 2-1 after only nine minutes, with Rocky Baptiste, from the spot, and Troy Hewitt netting for Harrow before Kevin Dobinson hit back. Kenta Nakashima made it 3-1 after 19 minutes and a double by Dan McGonigle in the

first six minutes of the second half put the game well beyond the islanders. Hewitt completed the six-hit with 12 minutes left.

Hendon forward Belal Aite-Ouakrim has scored nine league goals this season – and six of them have come at Concord's expense. He added a double on Saturday to the four he scored in the home game back in August, but this time without any reward. Tony Stokes had given Concord the lead with a 29th-minute penalty and Gary Ogilvie made it 2-0 shortly afterwards. Goals either side of half-time by Aite-Ouakrim put the visitors on terms only for Steve King's 64th-minute effort to give Concord a 3-2 victory and strengthen their play-off bid.

Billy Crook's goal after 63 minutes beat visitors Wealdstone and ended Tooting's run of five successive league draws and six games without a win. The Terrors also hit the woodwork three times, though they had top scorer Rob Haworth dismissed in added time.

Which leaves the relegation battle, and that took an intriguing turn as the bottom three all won. Danny Elgar gave Croydon Athletic a 79th minute lead at Margate and Frankie Sawyer completed a 2-0 victory with his first goal of the season. It has taken him four clubs to break his duck, having previously failed to hit the target for Cray, Hastings and Chipstead. Margate leading marksman Shaun Welford hit a post in the first half.

Croydon stay at the foot of the table but only three points cover the bottom five. Folkestone dropped two places to 21st after their 2-1 home defeat by Aveley, who climbed above them. Andy Howell put the Millers ahead on the half-hour but they had Josh Llewellyn sent off soon after half-time and James Everitt headed the equaliser in the 66th minute, his seventh goal of the season, but his first in the league. Howell, though, struck again for the ten men four minutes later.

Maidstone also moved above Folkestone and to within a point of their victims, 18th-placed Hastings, whom they beat 2-1 at the Pilot Field. Hastings took the lead through Russ Eldridge after 25 minutes and looked set to put some daylight between themselves and the bottom four. Adrian Stone equalised in the 72nd minute and Danny Hockton won it for the Kent side four minutes later before having a late penalty saved.

Division One North

East Thurrock United turned on the style on Saturday by scoring four unanswered goals, all in the first half, at Enfield Town. It was their tenth successive Division One North victory.

Enfield went into the game full of confidence after a 5-1 midweek triumph at Sudbury but they had no answer to a dazzling display by the table-toppers. Kris Newby opened their account after 16 minutes and added another on 24 minutes, Max Cornhill's quickly-taken free-kick made it 3-0 and Newby completed a hat-trick two minutes before half-time, taking his tally to 14 league goals and 19 in all. The scoreline hardly flattered Rocks, who also hit the woodwork three times.

They remain five points clear of Needham Market, who have three games in hand. The top two have yet to meet and their clashes at Needham on Saturday week and at Corringham on April 9 could be decisive.

East Thurrock's neighbours Tilbury tried hard to do them a favour at Needham on Saturday but went down 2-1. Nathan Stone scored at either end of the first half and although Michael Toner reduced the arrears just after the hour the Marketmen held on.

Maldon & Tiptree were the only other side in the top six to play - four matches were called off because of waterlogged pitches – and their ten men stole a 1-1 draw at Grays with a goal four minutes into added time by Ollie Berquez. Dean Pennant had given Grays a 64th minute lead from a free-kick awarded for an offence for which Grant Cooper was red-carded.

Despite their midweek mishap, Sudbury regained seventh place with a 2-2 draw at Ware thanks to a last-minute header by Steve Wareham. Murat Karagul put Ware ahead after 19 minutes and Matt Mitchell added another early in the second half before James Baker started Sudbury's comeback in the 63rd minute.

Luck is on Waltham Forest's side, and they are very grateful. They hosted Leyton in a battle of the bottom two at Cricklefield, with both sides seeking only their second win of the season, and it was Forest who got it thanks to a lone 55th minute goal by new signing Ian Luck. It was enough to take Forest off the foot of the table and dump Leyton there, though Leyton have three games in hand.

Great Wakering cruised to a 4-1 home win over Cheshunt, led by John Bradley who netted their first goal on 24 minutes and their last on 67. In between, Dan Trenkel and Ashley Hawkins also found the target, while Cheshunt had to wait until the last minute for their consolation from David Hicks.

It was a case of blink and you'll miss it at Heybridge, where both goals in a 1-1 draw against Waltham Abbey came in the space of a minute. Luke Callander put Swifts ahead in the 50th minute only for Steve Cawley to hit straight back. Both sides were later reduced to ten men after Danny Barber and Jack Devaney clashed.

Division One South

There were two big matches in Division One South on Saturday and it was Metropolitan Police and Bognor who came out of them smiling.

Table-topping Police saw off third-placed Leatherhead at Imber Court thanks to a single goal by Craig Watkins after 14 minutes. Tanners had the chance to equalise in the second half but Tommy Hutchings missed a penalty.

Bognor, fourth, won 2-1 at second-placed Whitehawk with Dan Royce heading home in the 76th minute to settle it. Michael Birmingham had scored for Rocks with a free-kick after 23 minutes and Sam Gargan replied two minutes later, making Hawks the first side in the league to reach 60 goals.

There was no change to the positions but the Met, on 48 points, and Bognor, on 43, have both played only 19 games while Whitehawk have 45 from 23 and Leatherhead 43 from 21.

Burgess Hill moved into the other play-off place with a 4-0 home win over bottom club Horsham YMCA, who have now conceded 78 goals. They held out until half-time at Leylands Park thanks to Steve Harper's penalty miss but Harper made up for it by putting Hillians ahead eight minutes after the break, the first of four goals in 20 minutes. Dan Gainsford made it 2-0 in the 63rd minute and Lloyd Cotton added another moments later before Danny Curd wrapped it up.

Walton Casuals are behind Hillians only on goal difference after snatching a 3-2 victory at

Worthing with a 90th minute goal by Danny Buckle, who had also put them ahead from the spot four minutes before half-time. Worthing turned it round with two goals in five minutes midway through the second half, Michael Hockett and debutant George Gaskin the marksmen, but Joe Kelly made it 2-2 in the 77th minute.

The Central Park blues continued for Sittingbourne, who were fifth. They dropped down two places after a 22nd minute goal by Ryan James for Eastbourne Town was enough to inflict their fourth successive home defeat.

Walton & Hersham, like Bognor, made it three wins out of three in 2011 and they are now up to eighth place. The hero was Graeme Purdy, one of the many players who have followed manager Chuck Martini from Godalming. Purdy, who actually joined Swans on Christmas Eve, scored his first goal for his new club in the 90th minute to give them a 3-2 home win over Faversham.

Swans led twice in the first half. Jean-Michel Sigere's penalty after 21 minutes was answered 12 minutes later by Dale Skelton, who pounced on the rebound after a David Bathgate penalty was saved. Shaun Elliott struck five minutes before the interval and Walton turned round 2-1 up only for Damian Abel to square it again three minutes after the restart.

The most exciting match of the day was at Chatham, where Merstham refused to be beaten despite falling behind four times and took a point from a 4-4 draw. Billy Shinnars opened the scoring for Chats after 17 minutes and Billy Marshall replied 11 minutes later. Leroy Huggins made it 2-1 in the 41st minute but this time Merstham were back on terms two minutes later thanks to Jordan Cheadle.

Bradley Potter was next to strike for Chatham two minutes after the restart and they held the lead this time for 12 minutes before Craig Dunne hit back. Shinnars got his second on 68 minutes and it proved to be the longest-lived lead. But only just. Ross White completed the goal spree with the fourth equaliser on 81 minutes.

Dulwich were the third team in the division to claim a 90th minute winner, Rob Gradwell netting the only goal of their game at Whitstable.

Iain Hendry scored after 15 minutes to give Fleet a 1-0 home win over Corinthian-Casuals. Wes Harrison hit the bar in the second half and Casuals came within inches of a point when Jamal Carr struck a post in the dying seconds.

In-form Chipstead took an eighth-minute lead through Ronnie Green, signed from Burgess Hill on New Year's Day, but had to settle for a 1-1 draw after Warren Schulz fired home a 25-yarder for visiting Ramsgate 14 minutes from time. Not far away, Whyteleafe's game against Godalming was postponed.

Ryman Youth League

Dulwich Hamlet's youngsters gave a great account of themselves before going down 6-2 to Newcastle in their FA Youth Cup third-round tie at Champion Hill on Thursday evening.

They even took the lead through Omar Lawson in front of a crowd of 439 who had braved heavy rain. It poured down all day in south London and it took much hard work to get the game played.

"If it had been any other game it would have been called off," said Dulwich chief executive Martin Eede. "But Newcastle were already in London so we made a real effort to get it on."

Newcastle were quickly on terms but the Ryman League club's youngsters held it to 1-1 at half-time before their opponents stepped up a gear in the second half, with four goals coming from Marcus Maddison, whom Eede described as "a fantastic player, the next Andy Carroll". Luke Joyce-Defreitas scored the second Dulwich goal.

"Our boys have done wonderfully to make such progress in the competition," said the proud Eede.

Two matches were played in the Ryman Youth League this week, both Central Division games on Wednesday.

Two George Griffiths goals in two second-half minutes earned second-placed Walton & Hersham a 2-0 victory at Sutton which brought them within three points of leaders Kingstonian, though the latter have a game in hand.

Whyteleafe moved up to fifth place as they came from behind to win 2-1 at Chipstead.

Cameron Watt put Chips ahead after 28 minutes but Chris Webster levelled it before the break and grabbed the winner on the hour.

CROYDON ATHLETIC F.C.

Croydon Athletic Football Club have admitted that they had played Charlie Taylor against Folkestone Invicta on Saturday, 21st August when he was still under written contract with Sutton United. The result of the match was a 2-0 win for Croydon Athletic.

The Club was charged with a breach of League Rules. Croydon Athletic F.C. have been fined and have had three points deducted from their records. The League table has been adjusted accordingly.

FA REGISTRATIONS MONTHLY BULLETIN

The following has been extracted from the last bulletin of the FA Registrations Department::

National Minimum Wage

We (*The FA*) understand that the rates are currently £5.93 per hour for workers aged 22 years and older, £4.92 per hour for workers aged 18-21 inclusive and £3.64 per hour for all workers under the age of 18, who are no longer of compulsory school age.

We suggest, therefore, that the Club calculate the number of hours that each player is likely to 'work' (under the guidelines) and then multiply these by the NMW rates given above to assess whether the contracted weekly wage is likely to breach NMW legislation. You will need to factor in your playing programme (both home and away) and training schedules over the length of the Contract.

The FA does not believe, based on NMW rates, that Contracts of less than £20 per week can be accepted. If you have any other queries regarding this legislation or other contractual matters please do not hesitate to contact the FA registrations team.

Expenses paid to Players

We cannot accept Contracts specifying actual expenses to be received. No Club should be contracting to pay a player expenses in this manner as once they are inserted into the Contract they become a contractual commitment and, theoretically, subject to taxable deductions.

Players are not entitled to receive reimbursement for travel expenses incurred from home to their Club's ground or training ground as expenses with no deduction for tax. The only recognised legitimate payment of travel expenses are those incurred on travelling to away matches where the Club does not run its own transport. Expenses for away game travel can be repaid subject to a completed and signed claim form being received at an agreed mileage rate (currently 40p) in accordance with HMRC guidelines. If asked by Clubs, providing fuel receipts is not evidence of a valid claim and expense forms should be completed.

As far as acceptable wording is concerned something to the effect that 'the Player will be reimbursed actual travelling expenses incurred whilst on Club business on production of valid receipts' will suffice.

The PAYE and semi-professional brochures remain on the FA website and although the tax codes are out of date the requirements as to how Clubs should account for expenses remain the same.
