#### WEEKEND REVIEW

##### Premier Division

Sutton United and Bury Town, leading the way in the Premier Division, both survived frights against lowly opposition to strengthen their position on Saturday. None of the seven teams below them managed to collect three points.

Aveley stunned Sutton at Gander Green Lane when, after the hosts had dominated the first half, Millers were awarded a penalty right on half-time and Charlton loanee Tamer Tuna converted. Another penalty followed just 12 seconds into the second half, this time for Sutton, and Craig Dundas levelled the scores. Sam Page headed home after 62 minutes and Sutton won 2-1.

Bury remain three points behind them with a game in hand after their 3-1 success at Croydon Athletic. The bottom club struck the first blow when Shabazz Baidoo scored after 14 minutes. Sam Reed levelled it on the half-hour and Craig Nurse put Bury ahead before half-time. Well on top, they had to wait until the 82nd minute for their third goal, a James Scowcroft penalty.

Lowestoft conceded three league goals for the first time since April last year and, worse still, found themselves 3-0 down at Tonbridge. But they fought back to share the points in a rousing game. Jon Beales headed home an 18<sup>th</sup> minute corner to put the Angels in front with the first of three goals in 16 minutes. Frannie Collin and Jay May were the other marksmen. Greg Crane gave the Trawlerboys an invaluable lifeline with a long-range strike five minutes before the break but it was the 81st minute before Dale Cockrill closed the gap further. Lowestoft piled on the pressure, Michael Frew made it 3-3 and Tonbridge had to cling on to avoid defeat.

Tonbridge would have taken over third place if they had held their lead but instead remain sixth while it's the Trawlerboys who are now third and, with their games in hand, are the most likely challengers to the top two.

There was more good news for Sutton at Concord, where Wealdstone powered to a 6-1 victory. The first four goals came from Richard Jolly, the Sutton striker who was allowed to go on loan to Stones after running into a lean patch. Jolly opened his account five minutes before half-time and wrapped up his foursome by the 53<sup>rd</sup> minute in a stunning display of deadly finishing. It was the first four-goal haul by a Wealdstone player for 13 years.

He must have fancied his chances of adding to his tally when Concord keeper Dale Brightly collected a second yellow card and forward Michael Begg took over the jersey. But Jolly allowed Peter Dean to take, and convert, a 73<sup>rd</sup> minute penalty and Dean also notched the sixth after Harry Elmes had netted a consolation for the islanders.

Concord's neighbours and fierce rivals Canvey moved above them and firmly into play-off contention with a lone-goal victory at Hastings. It was an 11<sup>th</sup> successive defeat for the Sussex club but they showed signs of improvement and were unlucky not to end that dismal sequence by taking at least a point.

Ben Davison was denied a Hastings opener by a post and instead it was Canvey's Craig Davidson who converted a 20<sup>th</sup> minute penalty which turned out to be the decider.

Kingstonian dropped to fourth place after going down 1-0 at home to Carshalton. Chances at either end were rare and the game was settled by a 72<sup>nd</sup> minute penalty by Gary Noel. Although Rob Tolfrey saved it, he was powerless to prevent Noel converting the rebound.

Cray stay fifth after a 2-2 draw at Hendon, where they twice took the lead. An early own goal by Eddie Munnely was enough to give Cray the edge at half-time, when Hendon introduced Greg Ngoyi, a recent signing from Wealdstone. The new boy proved his worth by equalising within six minutes, only for Chris Saunders to restore Cray's advantage on the hour. Danny Dyer tied it up again with 15 minutes left.

Paul Kennett headed home from a corner to give Horsham a fourth-minute lead at Hornchurch. It was the third successive game in which Hornets had gone in front early and, having lost the previous two 7-1 and 3-1 at home, they must have wondered whether it was a good idea. But Urchins could not turn their possession into goals and Billy Dunn jinked through to make it 2-0 just before the end.

Horsham's win means that there is a yawning ten-point gap above the bottom five, with Aveley remaining a point ahead of Hastings, Maidstone, Folkestone and Croydon.

Maidstone may have discovered the secret ingredient for survival; keep off the pitch. They were without a game and climbed above Folkestone, who were beaten 4-2 at Billericay. Cedric Ngakam pounced on some slack defence to open Billericay's account on 22 minutes and James Lawson made it 2-0 nine minutes later.

The sides then exchanged goals in the second half. Darren Smith pulled one back from the spot two minutes after the restart and Harrison Chatting netted Billericay's third two minutes later. Simon Austin reduced the arrears again on 72 minutes and it was only in the closing moments that Lawson clinched victory with his second. The Essex boys are now within six points of the play-off places.

Harrow and Margate slogged out a goalless draw at Earlsmead. Shaun Welford hit the bar for Margate, as did Dewayne Clarke for Harrow.

### **Division One North**

First-half goals by Sam Newson and Craig Parker helped Needham Market to reclaim the Division One North leadership with a 3-1 victory at Romford on Saturday. Newson struck after 21 minutes and Parker added a penalty after 38, and it looked as if that would be the end of the scoring. Then Matt Toms struck for Romford in the 90<sup>th</sup> minute, only for their brief hope to be snuffed out by Nathan Stone's immediate reply.

Craig Parker's penalty took his league goals this season to 20 – the second player to reach this mark so far this season

Needham are a point ahead of East Thurrock with three games in hand after the Rocks suffered an unexpected 2-1 home defeat by improving Heybridge. Kris Newby gave the hosts an 11<sup>th</sup>-minute lead, firing in a free-kick for his 24<sup>th</sup> goal of the season, but fine goalkeeping by Ollie Morris-Sanders denied Rocks after that and he was fully rewarded by second-half goals from Russell Pond and Luke Callander.

A close contest looked in prospect at Sudbury, where Potters Bar were the visitors in a battle of two teams challenging for the play-offs. A straight red card for Bar's Billy Sentance as early as the third minute changed that, and Lee Townrow fired a hat-trick as Sudbury powered to a 6-0 victory. Daniel Emmanuel opened the scoring in the 27<sup>th</sup> minute and Townrow headed the second in the 37<sup>th</sup> minute. He struck again shortly after the interval and completed his hat-trick with the fifth goal in the 75<sup>th</sup> minute. Tom Devaux had made it 4-0 and Liam Whittaker hit the sixth.

The big match at the bottom of the table was at Tilbury, where Ilford were forced to transfer their home game because of problems at Cricklefield. Junior Appiah put Ilford ahead five minutes before the break but Dockers made the most of their unexpected home advantage, equalising through Sam West in the 50<sup>th</sup> minute and claiming a 2-1 victory with a Ben Bradbury penalty ten minutes from the end.

Waltham Abbey maintained their play-off push with two unanswered goals at home to Grays,

but only after keeper Harry Ricketts had performed superbly to foil the visitors in the first half. Kieran Ogunkoya then gave Abbey the lead on the hour and Tom Laxton finished it off in added time.

Joe Collins scored on the hour to earn Maldon a 1-1 home draw with Brentwood, who had gone ahead in the 20<sup>th</sup> minute through Darren Blewitt.

Matters followed a very similar course at Thamesmead, where Cheshunt went ahead through Darrell Cox in the 19<sup>th</sup> minute and Gabriel Momodu replied in the 68<sup>th</sup> minute. The home side had the chances to win as they piled on the pressure but it finished 1-1.

Enfield Town edged into the play-off picture with a 2-0 victory at Redbridge. There was another good goalkeeping performance here as Town took 58 minutes to find a way past the defiant Elliott Justham. Adam Wallace eventually made the breakthrough and Jon Moore added the second 12 minutes from time.

Harlow beat Great Wakering 1-0 in the other game, the only goal a Daniel Brown penalty midway through the second half.

### **Division One South**

Bognor Regis Town bounced back from their 4-0 defeat at Faversham in midweek to win Division One South's match of the day on Saturday.

The league's best crowd of the day, 681, turned out at Nyewood Lane to see third-placed Rocks take on table-topping Metropolitan Police and most of them went home happy after a single goal was enough for the hosts to take the points and close the gap at the top to two points. Ben Johnson scored the crucial goal after 15 minutes from a pass by Luke Nightingale, who had a chance to claim his 20<sup>th</sup> of the season in the last minute but saw his penalty saved by Dave Smalley.

A lone goal was also enough for Whitehawk to retain second place, though they have played four more games than both their rivals. Josh Jones scored with eight minutes left at Walton Casuals, who are just outside the play-off spots themselves, and it came with Hawks down to ten men after Sam Gargan's dismissal.

Leatherhead, who started the season so well, are fast losing ground on the top three. Two more points slipped through their grasp with a 2-2 draw at lowly Whitstable. Ian Pulman gave the Kent side the lead in each half but Tanners replied through Mu Maan and Mark Simmons.

Burgess Hill strengthened their grip on fifth place by romping to a 4-0 home win over out-of-touch Whyteleafe, still firmly mired in the relegation zone. It was 35 minutes before Danny Gainsford headed home to open the scoring but Steve Harper made it 2-0 at half-time and struck again just before the hour mark, leaving the impressive Darren Boswell to wrap it up.

Another Sussex club to win 4-0 were Worthing and they did it away from home against Sittingbourne, whose play-off hopes are fading despite the loyalty of their players in the face of financial troubles. Mike Hockett put Worthing ahead with a ninth-minute penalty and a George Gaskin double made it 3-0 at the break. Worse was to follow for the home side in the 62<sup>nd</sup> minute when they conceded a second penalty. This time it was converted by Callum Saunders but not before the home side's Billy Eves was sent off after an incident while waiting for the kick to be taken.

Chipstead will rue a missed opportunity after their 0-0 home draw with Walton & Hersham. Jason Thompson had a penalty saved in the 36<sup>th</sup> minute and Chips could not profit after Walton were reduced to ten men early in the second half when Ashley Quashie was dismissed for a 'professional foul' on Kofi Quartey. It makes you wonder how often two players whose names begin with Q have been involved in such an incident.

The points were shared, too, at Fleet where Faversham must have hoped to maintain their play-off challenge. Jamie McClurg put Fleet ahead just before half-time in an entertaining affair and only ten minutes were left when Faversham skipper Tom Hickman made it 1-1.

The same result looked likely at Godalming until Merstham's Ross White converted Harry Ottaway's pass in the 87<sup>th</sup> minute to give the visitors a 2-1 win. They had taken the lead six minutes before the interval when Dale Marvell punished a wayward clearance and Godalming replied midway through the second half with a volley from Antonio Simeone.

Mark Lovell's 13<sup>th</sup> goal of the season for Ramsgate proved lucky, setting them on their way to a 3-1 home win over Corinthian-Casuals. It came after 22 minutes and the lead was increased 12 minutes later by Paul Axon. Shaun Lucien reduced the arrears early in the second half and Rams had some nervous moments before Liam Quinn clinched the points with 14 minutes left.

Bottom club Horsham YMCA were held to a 1-1 home draw by Chatham after Gavin Gordon put the hosts ahead from a 25th-minute corner. Anthony Hogg equalised on the stroke of half-time and was denied a winner only by Mark Fox's excellent save.

Eastbourne's trip to Dulwich had to be postponed. The police closed off access to the Champion Hill ground after a man was stabbed to death nearby during the night.

### **Ryman Youth League**

Maidstone United are providing rich entertainment in the Ryman Youth League. A week after going down 4-3 at Tonbridge, their first defeat of the season, they entertained Eastbourne Town and regained the South-East Division leadership by scoring four times in the last 13 minutes to come out on top in a nine-goal thriller.

A Matt Burroughs penalty and a Brett Caiger striker put the visitors 2-0 up at half-time and, after Jack Simon opened Maidstone's account, Caiger completed a hat-trick to give his side a secure 4-1 lead.

Secure? Maybe not. After Simon reduced the arrears in the 77<sup>th</sup> minute, Sean Johnson grabbed two in two minutes and Steve Sage pulled off an unlikely victory three minutes from time.

Burgess Hill had gone to the top of the table earlier in the week, beating Tonbridge 2-0 at Leylands Park thanks to a second-half double by Kit Tregear.

The Hillians, though, slipped back to third when they were also repassed by Whitehawk, who won 2-0 at home as well. Kieron Pamment and Matt Daniel were their marksmen against Ashford (Kent).

Bottom club Horsham YMCA went down 5-2 at home to Worthing, who took an early 2-0 lead through Curtis Milner and Dec Jenkins. Harry

Magnus pulled one back but Jenkins scored again before half-time and Sam Mannings added a double before George Matthews hit YM's second near the end.

Kingstonian's domination of the Central Division continued with a 3-1 home win over Leatherhead. Matthew Rose-Hazel netted twice and Jack Wadmore once before Kieran Lunn's consolation.

Sutton cruised to a 5-1 home victory over Thamesmead. They were two up in eight minutes through Lewis Wilson and Bane Dundavan, though Wilson's own goal gave Thamesmead hope before the interval. Second-half strikes by Louis John, Dundavan and Luke Farrer made sure for the hosts.

The West Division seems to be the place to go if you admire defensive qualities. Only one goal was scored in three games and even that, from Lewis Afflick, came in the 90<sup>th</sup> minute. Afflick's effort earned unbeaten Staines a 1-0

home win over Ashford (Middx) and brought them level on points with leaders Hayes, who have played two more games.

Goalnets remained unruffled at Woking and Northwood, where Harrow and Hampton were the respective visitors.

## SUCCESSIVE VICTORIES
