#### Macron Manager of the Month

This is handed to the manager whose team has the best points-per-game record during the month and it was Billericay Town manager Craig Edwards who edged out Sutton United's Paul Doswell in the battle for the Premier Division award.

Billericay won five and drew one of their six February games, good for 16 points as they burst into play-off contention, while table-topping Sutton had to settle for 15 thanks to a lone defeat among five victories.

Grays Athletic manager Julian Dicks took the honours in Division One North. The former West Ham hero had been linked with a return to his old club as reserve team manager, a job that eventually went to Steve Lomas, but he did not let the speculation affect his commitment to Grays as they won all three of their matches during February to put themselves in with a play-off chance. Heybridge boss Mark Hawkes just missed out; his side played five times, winning four and drawing one.

Honours in Division One South went to Whyteleafe's Nicky English, whose team started the month deep in relegation trouble after taking only one point from their previous eight games. February was a different story, with four wins out of five. A club has to play at least three league games during the month to qualify for this prize so

Leatherhead's Mick Sullivan missed out despite a 100 per cent record; the

Tanners took to the field only twice in February. Four other teams were unbeaten during the month but could not match Whyteleafe's points-per-game average.

### **Macron Team Performance of the Month**

Lowestoft Town saw their Premier Division title chances disappear during January and February as they suffered a run of six games without a victory. They ended that gloomy spell in style, thumping Hendon 8-1 at Crown Meadow to earn the Premier Division award.

Sutton United came under consideration three times for the prize, which is for the single best performance during the month, as they saw off three of their closest rivals: Cray, Lowestoft and Tooting. Their 1-0 defeat at Hendon was also considered. Harrow's 6-0 victory over Horsham (completing a 13-1 'aggregate win' in the space of a few weeks) was a candidate, as was Hastings United's 3-2 win against Tooting, their first success since early October.

Away victories in games between play-off contenders provided three of the candidates for the Division One North award and it was Enfield Town who took the honours with an impressive 6-0 romp at Brentwood Town. Potters Bar were involved in the other two; a 3-1 win at Romford and a 4-0 home defeat by Waltham Abbey. This is the only one of the monthly awards for which cup performances count so Maldon & Tiptree's 2-0 success at Fleet in the Championship Manager Cup quarter-finals was also mentioned.

Whyteleafe grabbed the Division One South award and, just like Horsham YMCA a month earlier, they earned it for beating high-flying Metropolitan Police. It was their first game of the month and their first league win in nine games. Not only that, but they did it away from home at Imber Court and in a 5-4 thriller.

Lowly Whitstable's 1-1 draw at leaders Bognor was a candidate, as were assorted away victories in the league by Leatherhead, Walton Casuals and Worthing. Leatherhead's Championship Manager Cup win at Cray, eliminating the final Premier Division side from the competition, was also considered but Whyteleafe's effort took the prize.

### **Sells Goalkeeping Academy Good Hands**

Billericay Town's great form during February helped Ashlee Jones to take the Premier Division prize. These awards go to the first-choice goalkeeper of the club with the best

defensive record in the month and Billericay conceded only one goal in their six games.

Heybridge may have just missed out in the manager of the month race but their defensive record, three goals conceded in five games, was the best in Division One North and Ollie Morris-Sanders collects the trophy.

Whitehawk's Lloyd Anderson took the Division One South prize. Hawks played three games and allowed two goals into their net, making them the only side in the division to concede less than a goal a game apart from Leatherhead, who kept clean sheets in both their games but again missed out because of the three-match qualification.

## **WEEKEND REVIEW**

### **Premier Division**

The Premier Division play-off race hotted up on Saturday, when only one of the top seven managed a win and the five teams immediately behind them all collected three points.

Leaders Sutton travelled to Wealdstone with marksman Richard Jolly vowing to do the business against a club with whom he spent such a successful loan spell last month. But it was not to be his day as Lee Chappell's last-minute goal earned Stones a 2-1 victory, confirming their emergence as play-off contenders and offering a glimmer of hope to Sutton's pursuers. Peter Dean's header gave Stones an early lead which Craig Dundas wiped out in the 57<sup>th</sup> minute. Sutton had the edge for much of the game but Chappell sunk them.

Bury are nine points behind in second place with two games in hand, but dropped two points in a 1-1 home draw with lowly Folkestone. The Kent side, bolstered by their 4-0 midweek victory, took the lead with a Darren Smith penalty on the half-hour and might have had more before Scott Chaplin converted Sam Reed's pass to level matters in the 63<sup>rd</sup> minute.

Lowestoft were the only winners among the leading group and are two points behind Bury with a game in hand. Jamie Forshaw provided the only goal of their game at Maidstone seven minutes after half-time, with a double save by Andy Reynolds denying new Maidstone signing Jay May a reply.

Tonbridge and Kingstonian still occupy the other two play-off spots after a highly-entertaining 1-1 draw at Kingsmeadow. Paul Vines gave K's a deserved lead eight minutes before the interval but the visitors gained the upper hand after the break and Jake Beecroft's 30-yard drive in the 78<sup>th</sup> minute made it a fair result.

K's can hardly feel secure in fifth place; there are seven teams within six points of them, most of them with games in hand.

Billericay, in sixth place, suffered a shock 1-0 defeat at Hastings, who moved out of the relegation zone. Full-back Ollie Rowe headed the vital goal after 43 minutes.

Concord slipped back two places to ninth after their 2-1 defeat at Cray, who moved up to eighth. It was the 66<sup>th</sup> minute before Tony Dolby opened the scoring from Jack Clark's free-kick and Leigh Bremner added a second 11 minutes later. Tony Stokes pulled one back five minutes later but the Essex side could not find an equaliser.

Another Essex club, Hornchurch, have put a rocky patch behind them and chalked up a third successive win. Martin Tuohy's fourth-minute goal was enough to beat bottom club Croydon Athletic, whose goalkeeper Charlie Mitten did well to keep the score down. Croydon threatened from time to time but had little to offer once Jeremy Williams received his second yellow card on 64 minutes. Urchins will take over fifth place if they beat Aveley on Tuesday.

Canvey and Harrow both stayed well in the hunt. The islanders had a comfortable 3-1 home win over Horsham. Rob King's free-kick gave Canvey an early lead which was extended by Jason Hallett midway through the first half and Alex Rhodes midway through the second. Jamie Cade pulled one back for the Hornets, who are now looking anxiously over their shoulders.

Rocky Baptiste's 22<sup>nd</sup> goal of the season was enough for Harrow at Carshalton. The veteran striker found the net with a looping header in the 28<sup>th</sup> minute. Both sides headed against the bar in the closing stages, Wayne Walters for Harrow and Joel Ledgister for Robins.

Relegation-threatened Aveley pulled off a crucial 2-1 win at Hendon. Tony Russell put them ahead after nine minutes and Danny Slatter made it 2-0 with a fierce drive from 30 yards in the 24<sup>th</sup> minute. Hendon quickly replied with a Brian Haule header but could not find an equaliser despite being on top for most of the rest of the game.

So, with three of the bottom five picking up points, daylight has appeared between them for the first time in several weeks, with Croydon and Maidstone now four points adrift. Folkestone, despite their draw, slip back to 20<sup>th</sup>, a point behind Hastings and Aveley, who are in turn closing the gap on Horsham which is down to five points.

There was just one match in the division involving two sides who seem unlikely to be involved in the tussles at either end of the table. That was at Tooting, where Margate went down 3-0. All the goals came in the last 20 minutes, starting with Jamie Byatt's cracker from 30 yards. Mike Heverin quickly headed the second and Tyrone Sealey wrapped it up in added time.

### **Division One North**

It's all square on points at the top of Division One North after Saturday's games, though Needham Market have a slight goal-difference advantage and a game in hand over rivals East Thurrock.

Max Cornhill's 69<sup>th</sup> minute header gave Rocks a 1-0 home win over Maldon, for whom Paul Shave earlier hit the bar, while their tenants, Grays, did them a huge favour by drawing 1-1 at Needham.

Sam Newson put the Marketmen ahead after 14 minutes but they failed to add to their tally and Dean Pennant squared it with a superb 25-yard strike six minutes after the break. Needham have drawn three of their last four home league games after winning their first 12.

The top pair, both on 70 points, have a massive 18-point advantage over their nearest rivals, who are now Brentwood. It seems that last month's 6-0 home defeat by Enfield was just what Blues needed; they became the first team to get a point at Needham in their next match and have won their next five, conceding only one goal. Potters Bar were their latest victims, going down to a lone goal just after the hour by defender Darren Blewitt at the

Brentwood Arena. Ryan Doyle's goalline clearance averted an equaliser.

Wingate dropped back to fourth after crashing 3-0 at home to unpredictable AFC Sudbury, now right in the play-off hunt themselves. Michael Shinn broke the deadlock with a free-kick after 66 minutes and the Suffolk side added two more in the last three minutes through Ryan Henshaw, a long-range rocket, and Dave Wareham.

Enfield are sixth but will feel they should have done better than their 2-2 draw at Heybridge. Liam Hope gave them a 23<sup>rd</sup> minute lead which Leon Osei doubled three minutes later. But it was all square again two minutes after half-time. Chris Bryan pulled one back with a deflected free-kick in the 33<sup>rd</sup> minute and Luke Callander levelled matters.

Getro Kilapi's 19<sup>th</sup> minute strike gave Harlow all three points from a scrappy affair at Waltham Abbey and maintained their slim hopes of a top-five place.

But Romford's challenge is fading fast. They crashed 3-0 at home to Tilbury, who took the lead with a Harry Cook effort after only two minutes. A Ben Turner own goal made it 2-0 at half-time and Steve Good headed the third in the dying minutes.

Tilbury looked in serious danger of the drop not so long ago but they are now ten points clear of the only relegation place, which is still occupied by Waltham Forest after their 0-0 draw with Great Wakering. Forest keeper Jason Willis earned his side their point.

Forest's landlords and fellow-strugglers Ilford maintained their two-point advantage with a 2-2 draw at Thamesmead. It was scoreless until Nick Davis struck for the hosts on 64 minutes. A penalty ten minutes later gave Adam Bolle the chance to reply and Clydie Roberts put the visitors ahead two minutes after that. Raphael Momodu's last-minute header, from a cross by twin brother Gabriel, denied Ilford two precious points.

Redbridge slipped into the bottom three, though they are nine points ahead of Forest, after their fourth successive 1-1 draw, this time at home to Ware. Luke Marshall's 78<sup>th</sup> minute goal for Ware looked likely to be the winner but Kevin McLeod's free-kick levelled it with two minutes to go.

## **Division One South**

The top three teams in Division One South scored 11 unanswered goals between them on Saturday. They remain covered by a five-point spread but there is now a ten-point gap to the rest of the field.

Bognor retained the leadership with a 3-0 victory at bottom club Horsham YMCA, leaving their hosts 13 points adrift of safety. Luke Nightingale's tenth-minute lob, his 22<sup>nd</sup> goal of the season, put them ahead, James Crane made it 2-0 soon after half-time and James Fraser completed the tally with seven minutes left.

Metropolitan Police, a point behind the leaders, beat Burgess Hill by the same margin at Imber Court. After a goalless first half, Craig Watkins ran from halfway, beating two defenders, to open the scoring in the 50<sup>th</sup> minute with his 21<sup>st</sup> of the campaign. Hillians then had Nick Fogden sent off, Chris Bourne added another goal in the 70<sup>th</sup> minute and Gary Drewett made sure a minute later.

Whitehawk are four points behind the Met and have played a game more. They became the first team in the league to reach the 80-goal mark, ending Whyteleafe's recent revival with a nap hand at East Brighton Park. It took them 58 minutes to break their duck with a Richard Carpenter strike, Paul Armstrong made it 2-0 in the 72<sup>nd</sup> minute and Hawks completed their haul with three in the last nine minutes, one from Ben Godfrey and a couple from Sam Gargan.

Leatherhead, in fourth place, slumped to a 2-0 home defeat by another reviving club, Godalming, who followed up their midweek win over the Met. A 19<sup>th</sup> minute strike by James Evans gave them the lead and Tommy Hutchings and Rob Hill were both denied an equaliser by the bar as Tanners dominated without finding their finishing touch. Substitute Chris Kiganda settled the issue in the last minute.

Burgess Hill remain fifth but are just a point ahead of Walton & Hersham, who have emerged as strong play-off candidates in recent weeks. They powered to an impressive 6-1 triumph at Worthing, who had top scorer Terry Dodd dismissed on the half-hour but were already trailing 2-0 to strikes by Gary Frewen and the melodically-named Bakary Bojang. In the last few minutes of the half

Graeme Purdy extended the lead and George Gaskin reduced it again. Any lingering Worthing hopes were snuffed out by Frewen's penalty on the hour, after which an Ashley Quashie double completed the six-hit, which followed up a 3-2 home win over the same opposition in midweek.

Swans are now above neighbours Walton Casuals, who slipped to eighth after becoming the latest victims of Ian Pulman's marksmanship for Whitstable. Pulman, whose recent form has been largely responsible for his side's climb towards safety, took his tally to 21 with a goal in each half at Walton, for whom Michael Barima made it 1-1 for a while. "I'm now doubting if the lads are good enough to get in the play-offs," tweeted disappointed Casuals manager Neil Shipperley ([www.twitter.com/rymanleagueneews](http://www.twitter.com/rymanleagueneews)).

Faversham also climbed above Casuals, though they will have wanted better than a 0-0 draw at home to Merstham. A late red card for joint top scorer Damian Abel made it a bad day for the hosts.

Corinthian-Casuals, YMCA's partners in the drop zone, lost 3-0 at home to Eastbourne and remained five points adrift of Chatham, though they have four games in hand. Matt Ferdinando scored midway through the first half, further goals coming after the interval from Dean Brooks and Tim Rivers as the Sussex side kept themselves well above the danger area.

Chatham themselves were beaten 3-1 at Fleet, who were two up at half-time through a Wes Harrison chip and a Lee Riddell penalty. Josh Pearson added a classy third with 11 minutes left and Aaron Firth managed a late consolation.

Ryan Golding's 32<sup>nd</sup> minute header was enough to earn Sittingbourne all three points at Chipstead, for whom Billy Harding hit a post from long range.

Ramsgate and Dulwich fought out a 0-0 draw. Dulwich keeper James Dunn pulled off a superb save to deny Warren Schulz a stoppage-time winner.

## **Ryman Youth League**

Six of the best were not quite enough for Staines Town in this week's Ryman Youth League games. Mario Quiassaca fired a first-half hat-trick in their 6-0 victory at Fleet but they failed to overtake Woking at the top of the West Division by a single goal.

Woking, who have played two more games, did just enough to retain pole position on the same night. George Frith was their hat-trick hero in a 4-0 win at Harrow. Ashford (Middx) took over third place from Hayes after beating them 2-1 at Short Lane. Perry Luckins scored both goals.

In the other West Division game Northwood trailed at half-time in their home game with bottom club Barnet Black but rallied to win 3-1. Romaine Walker equalised with a penalty and also scored the go-ahead goal.

Two goals in three first-half minutes by Cameron Watt and David Dean earned Chipstead a surprise 2-0 victory over Central Division leaders Kingstonian.

K's remain eight points clear because second-placed Leatherhead went down 2-1 at home to Sutton thanks to a last-minute goal by Michael McConnell.

Carshalton also scored two in three minutes before the break in their 2-1 success at Metropolitan Police. Casey McCabe and Tommy Bradford were their marksmen.

Burgess Hill are a point behind South-East Division leaders Whitehawk after accounting for Ashford (Kent) with a lone Kit Tregear goal at Leylands Park.

Worthing drew 2-2 with Eastbourne Town, a pair of goals by Brett Caiger for Eastbourne sandwiching two by Shaun Charles for the young Rebels, while Horsham YMCA still have only one point to their credit after going down 2-0 at home to Tonbridge, who scored late in each half through Greg Keddy and Joe Walker.

Five league matches were postponed, as was the second-round tie in the Lucas Fettes Youth Cup between Maidstone and Cray. The other tie went ahead and Welling beat Wingate 2-0, Danny Nicholl scoring in each half.
