



## Midweek Update – Season 2012/13 No.13

### Ryman Premier

A GOAL by recent signing Danny Mills lifted **Whitehawk** to the top of the table on Tuesday. They needed a point from their home game against **Met Police** to displace Hampton from pole position – and a point was all they got from a 1-1 draw. Allan Tait scored for the Met after 21 minutes and former Carshalton man Mills replied ten minutes before the interval.

**Bury** came from behind to win 3-1 at **East Thurrock** and move into the play-off places. Sam Collins put the hosts ahead on the half-hour but John Sands equalised soon after the change of ends. Allicion Blake and John Kennedy completed the turnaround.

Veteran midfielder Jonathan Hunt fired home from 25 yards midway through the second half to give **Enfield Town** the lead at home to **Harrow** and Adam Wallace made it 2-0.

Paul Vines, who joined **Cray** from **Carshalton** last month, netted the decider as his new team beat his old one 3-2 at Bromley. Leigh Bremner put Cray ahead after 24 minutes but the visitors rallied and led 2-1 at the interval thanks to Nathaniel Pinney and Justyn Roberts. Bremner squared it again on 66 minutes and Vines got the winner five minutes later.

**Hendon** are still without an away goal and remain in the relegation zone, though now only on goal difference, after a 0-0 draw at **Lewes** while two other Sussex clubs, based either side of Lewes, shared the points at **Hastings** where Bailo Camara gave the hosts a 25<sup>th</sup>-minute lead and Ashley Robinson replied for **Bognor** 12 minutes later.

### Ryman North

A FOUR-GOAL salvo from Jeff Hammond made it another unhappy outing on home turf for **Redbridge** on Tuesday. Hammond scored after 21, 24, 39 and 77 minutes as **Harlow** strolled to a 4-0 victory.

The result lifted Harlow a couple of places up the table, to 17<sup>th</sup>, and meant that there is a six-point gap between Brentwood, the new 19<sup>th</sup>-placed team, and Ilford in 20<sup>th</sup>.

**Ilford**, who are above Redbridge on goal difference, had hopes of staying in touch with the sides above them after Usama Hamdan gave them a shock half-time lead at **Grays**.

Ryan Kirby equalised two minutes after the break and Junior Baker netted after 72 minutes to give Grays a 2-1 win which lifted them to third place.

**Ware** stayed four points adrift at the bottom after going down 4-1 at **Witham**, who moved into the top half of the table. Two quick goals from John Watson and Jason Fontaine midway through the first half put Witham in charge.

David Hunt gave Ware hope three minutes after the interval and only 12 minutes were left when Rob Whitnell restored the two-goal gap. Then Watson struck again to make quite sure.

A goal in added time by Junior Appiah had earned **Aveley** a 2-1 home win over **Needham Market** on Monday and lifted them to second place.

The Marketmen, boasting the league's best away record and unbeaten on their travels, looked on course to maintain that form when Keiran Leabon gave them a seventh-minute lead with a rasping 20-yard daisy-cutter.

But Jordan Cox equalised in the 27th minute, turning in Junior Dadson's low cross from close range. A draw would have been a fair result but Millers nicked it at the death when Appiah broke through on the right and fired past Louis Johnson in the Needham goal.

## FA Trophy

DESPITE twice taking the lead through Peter Dean, **Wealdstone** went down 3-2 in their replay at Corby on Wednesday, the winning goal coming in the second minute of added time.

Dean gave Stones, semi-finalists last season, a ninth-minute lead which they held until the stroke of half-time, when Sam Ives levelled it.

Another goal from Dean restored Wealdstone's advantage in the 68th minute but Carl Piergianni made it 2-2 in the 82nd minute and Josh Moreman grabbed the late decider which, in truth, Corby deserved, having had the upper hand for much of the night.

**Kingstonian** wasted no time in wrapping up their replay at **Brentwood** on Tuesday, scoring four times in the game's first quarter.

Matt Pattison and Kieran Murphy put them two up in nine minutes, Craig Mullen added the third and Pattison struck again to rule out any prospect of an upset victory for the Ryman North side. There was no further scoring until added time at the end of the game, when Daryl Robson's consolation goal made it 4-1. K's now have an attractive home tie against Conference Premier high-flyers Dartford.

**Hampton** also looked set for a comfortable replay victory but, in the end, they had to hang on for their 3-2 home win over Premier rivals **Leiston**. Charlie Moone opened the scoring after six minutes and goals by Tom Hickey and Moone late in the first half sent Hampton in for the break with a 3-0 lead.

Rhys Henry pulled one back seven minutes after the restart and when Gareth Heath scored with 11 minutes left it meant a tricky end to the game for the hosts before they clinched their home tie against Conference South side Chelmsford, who won their replay 4-2 after extra time at Dover.

So three Ryman League clubs are through to the first round proper, including Maidstone who were successful on Saturday.

Our other two sides were beaten in their away replays, **Canvey** took a first-half lead at Chesham through Bradley Woods-Garness but went down 2-1, the winner coming with three minutes left. **Leatherhead**, facing a difficult visit to Conference South side Bath, held out for 36 minutes but were beaten 2-0.

Meanwhile, Canvey Island's other side, Concord Rangers, were celebrating a remarkable goal scoring feat by Jason Hallett, who claimed SEVEN of their goals in an 8-2 county cup victory over Essex Senior League side Takeley.
