Ryman Premier

Bognor climbed four places to fourth in the table with a 3-1 victory at **Cray** on Tuesday. Cray have won only one of their last 11 league games and this was their seventh home defeat.

Ashley Robinson's 13th-minute opener for Rocks was quickly answered by Leigh Bremner. But James Crane restored Bognor's lead three minutes before the interval and Harvey Whyte, who has just rejoined the club from Havant, added the third with 15 minutes left.

John Sands scored his 14th goal of the season to give **Bury** a 1-0 victory at **Canvey**. It came after 24 minutes and lifted Bury one place to seventh, although they are only a point behind second-placed Wealdstone. Canvey dropped to fifth.

Margate hoped to reclaim second place on Wednesday by taking at least a point at **Met Police**. It was the only one of the night's games to get under way but it failed to go the distance. Play was abandoned 12 minutes after half-time with the Met leading 1-0, Allan Tait the scorer.

Ryman North

A five-goal salvo from Jeff Hammond enabled **Grays** to return to second place on Tuesday with a 6-0 thrashing of **Sudbury** at Rush Green in the only one of the six scheduled midweek fixtures in the division to beat the weather.

The writing was on the wall for Sudbury after just 44 seconds, when a corner was allowed to drop on the goalline for Hammond to tap in.

His second, an 11th-minute header, was from similar range and he completed his hat-trick in the 25th minute after rounding keeper Alex Archer.

That one owed a little to good fortune as he would have been offside but for Sudbury's Ryan Henshaw lying injured in his own penalty area.

Hammond struck again in the 32nd minute to complete a rare feat. Not many players, surely, have scored four times for two different clubs in the space of two months, but Hammond nabbed all the goals as Harlow won 4-0 at Redbridge in mid-November.

This time he added another one in the 55th minute before allowing Craig Pope to claim the sixth with a near-post header from a 66th-minute corner.

Ryman South

Maidstone are back on top, edging ahead of Dulwich with a 2-0 victory at **Burgess Hill** on Tuesday. Once again their hero was Ade Olorunda. He came off the bench to score his first two league goals of the season on Saturday as Stones came from 2-0 down to draw with Crawley Down, and he netted twice more, in the 11th and 73rd minutes, to secure Tuesday's win.

Walton & Hersham were held to a 1-1 home draw by **Horsham**, for whom Glen Woodburn's 54th-minute goal wiped out Graeme Purdy's effort for the home side just before the interval.

Isthmian League Cup

The top two clubs in the Ryman Premier table crashed out on Tuesday. Knockout specialists **Hastings** went through to the semi-finals with a 4-3 home win over leaders **Whitehawk**, despite being 20 places below them in the table.

Zac Attwood, player-manager Sean Ray and Brad Goldberg gave Hastings a 3-0 half-time lead and, after Jerahl Hughes pulled one back, Goldberg struck again to make it 4-1 with 20 minutes to go.

Hawks had beaten Canvey 5-4 from an equally unpromising position ten days earlier but tonight they left their comeback too late. Josh Jones pulled one back in the 88th minute and it was three minutes into added time when Hakeem Araba scored their third.

Second-placed **Wealdstone** were beaten 1-0 at **Dulwich** in their delayed fourth-round tie, compensating Dulwich for losing the Ryman South leadership to Maidstone. Ryan James scored the only goal after 49 minutes. Dulwich now meet Kingstonian in the quarter-finals.

The night's other quarter-final produced a goalless draw between **Thamesmead** and **Thurrock**, and it was Ryman North play-off contenders Thamesmead who went through, beating the Premier strugglers 4-2 on penalties.
